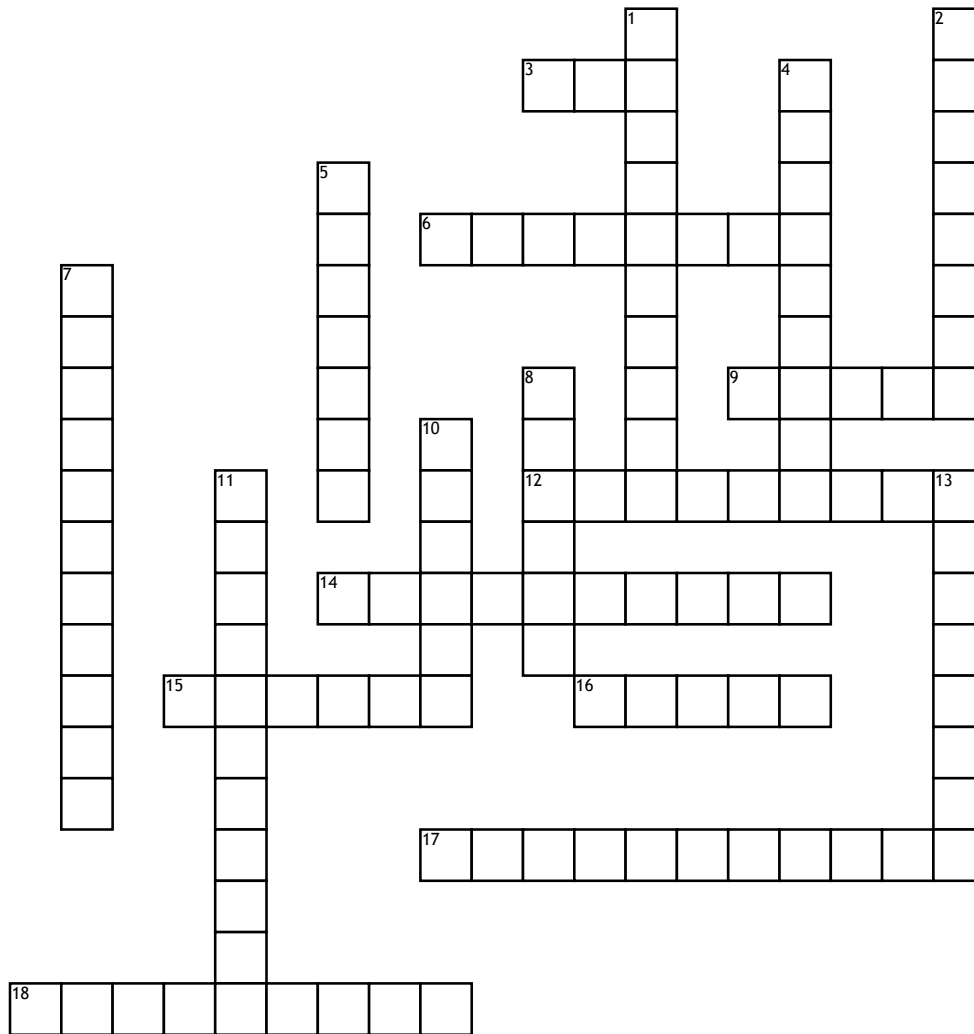

- 14. the state of being confined as a prisoner, especially for political or military reasons

- 1. information, especially of a biased or misleading nature, used to promote or publicize a particular political cause or point of view
 - 2. the deliberate killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation
 - 4. a thing that discourages or is intended to discourage someone from doing something

- 5. a governmental system led by a dictator having complete power, forcibly suppressing opposition and criticism, regimenting all industry, commerce, etc., and emphasizing an aggressive nationalism and often racism
- 7. a policy of extending a country's power and influence through diplomacy or military force
- 8. an official agreement or treaty
- 10. lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern
- 11. the making of amends for a wrong one has done, by paying money to or otherwise helping those who have been wronged
- 13. the policy of protecting the interests of native-born or established inhabitants against those of immigrants
