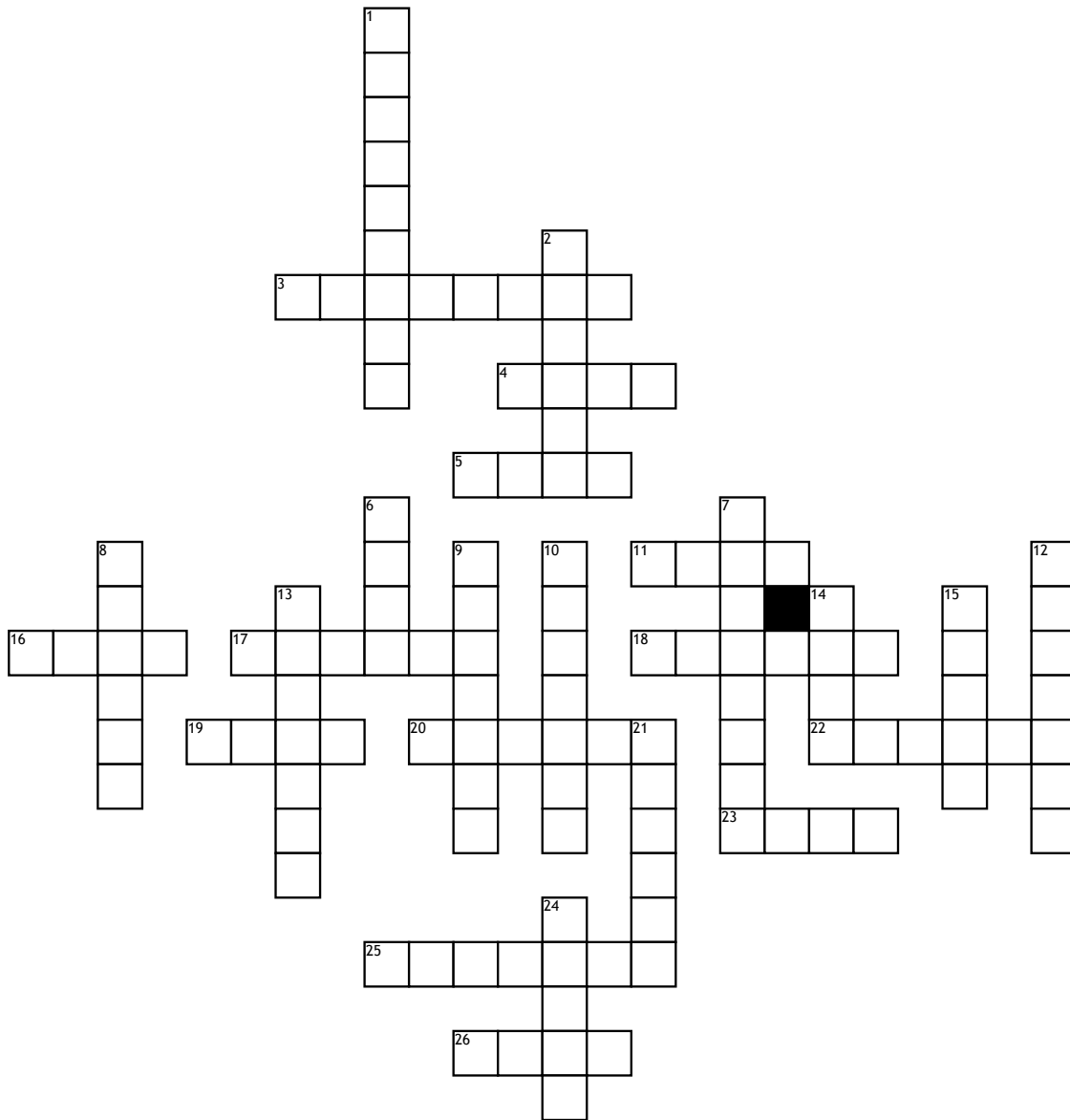


# Sailor Speak Crossword
