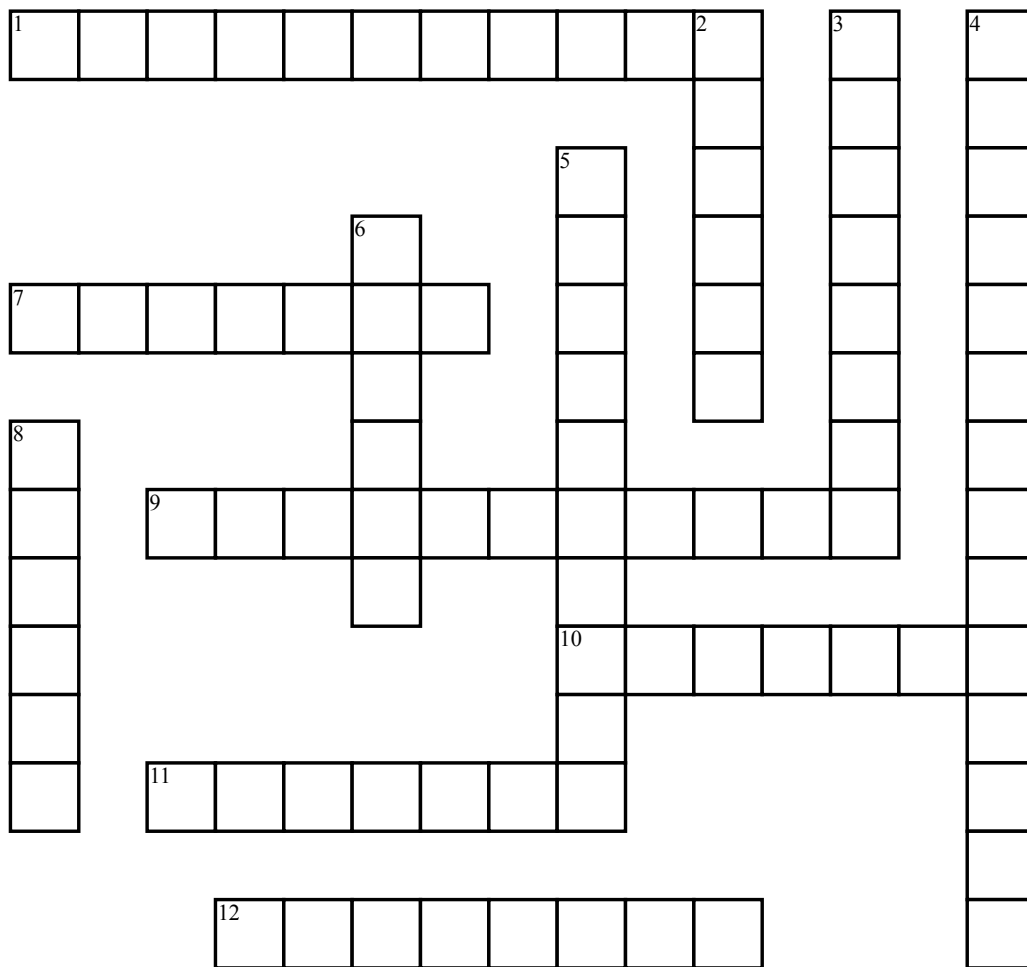


# Scarlet letter Vocabulary
