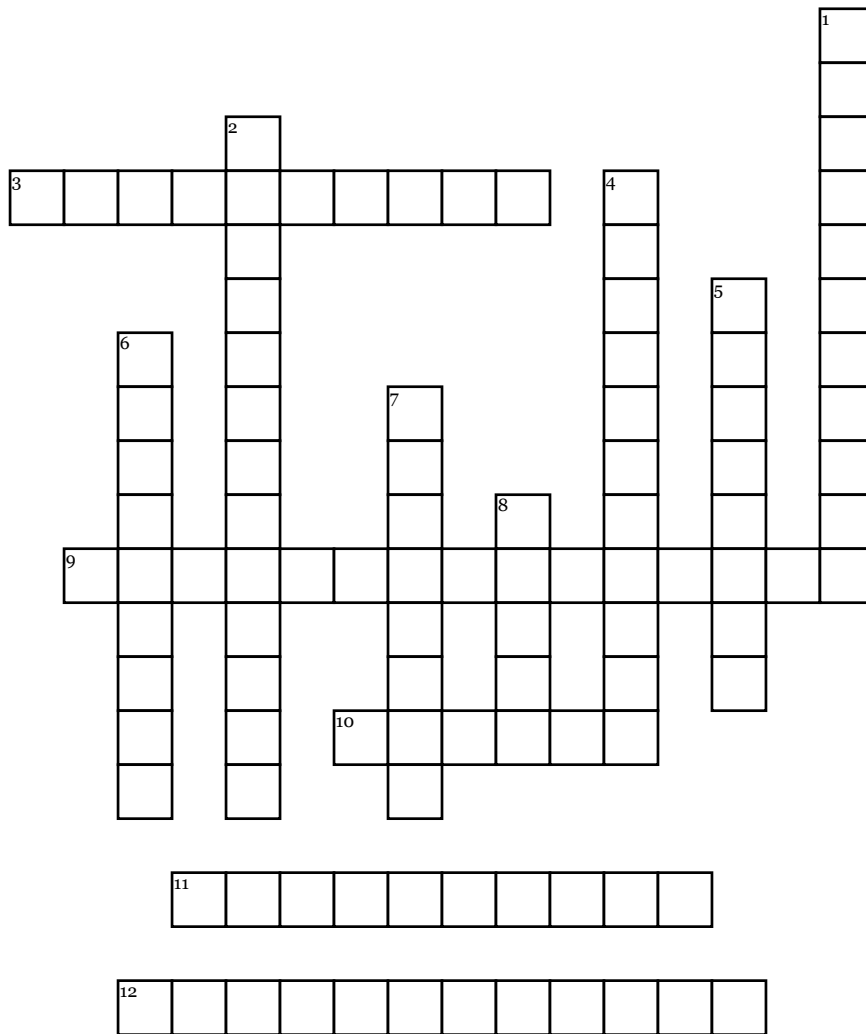


# Scarlet's Letter
