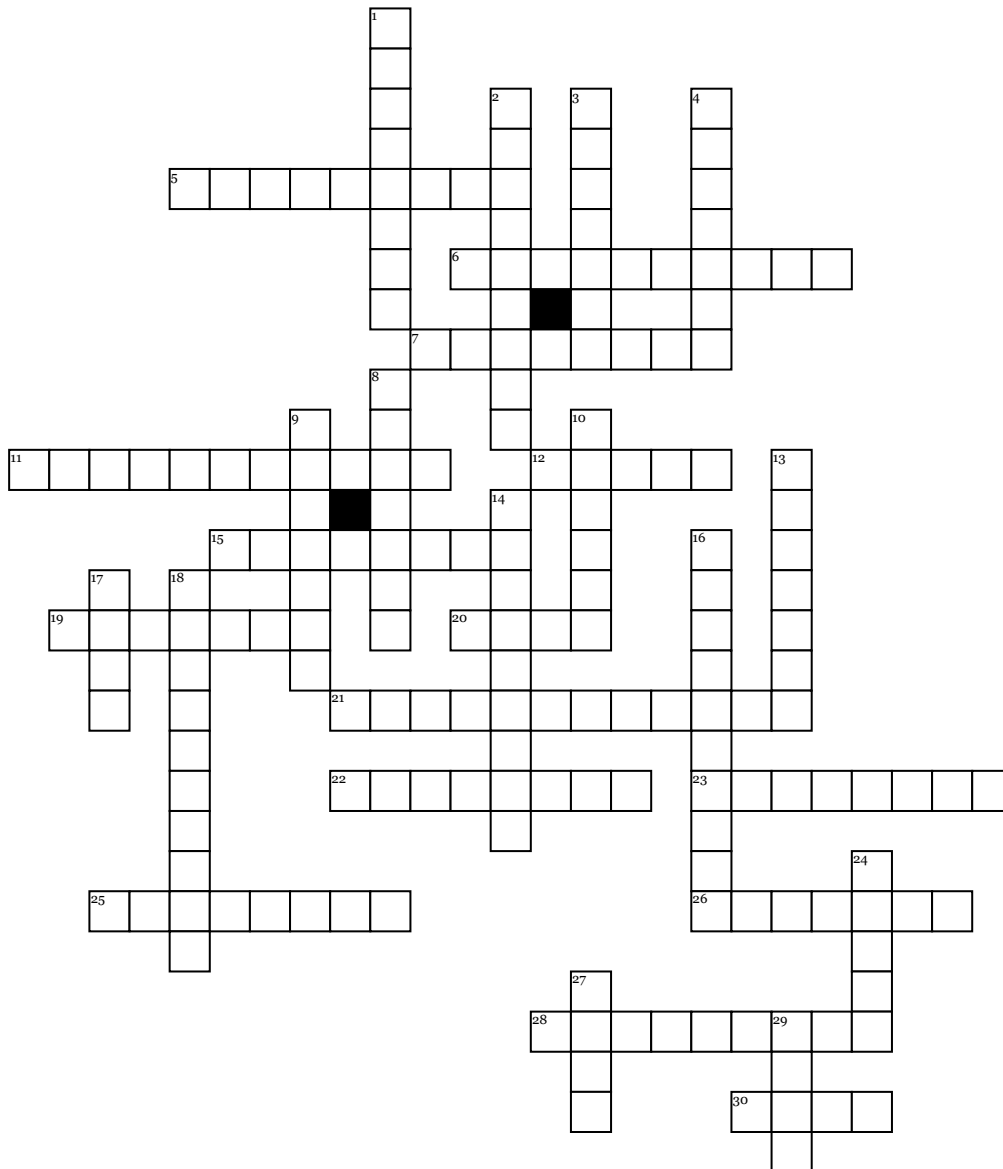


Schooled Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle
