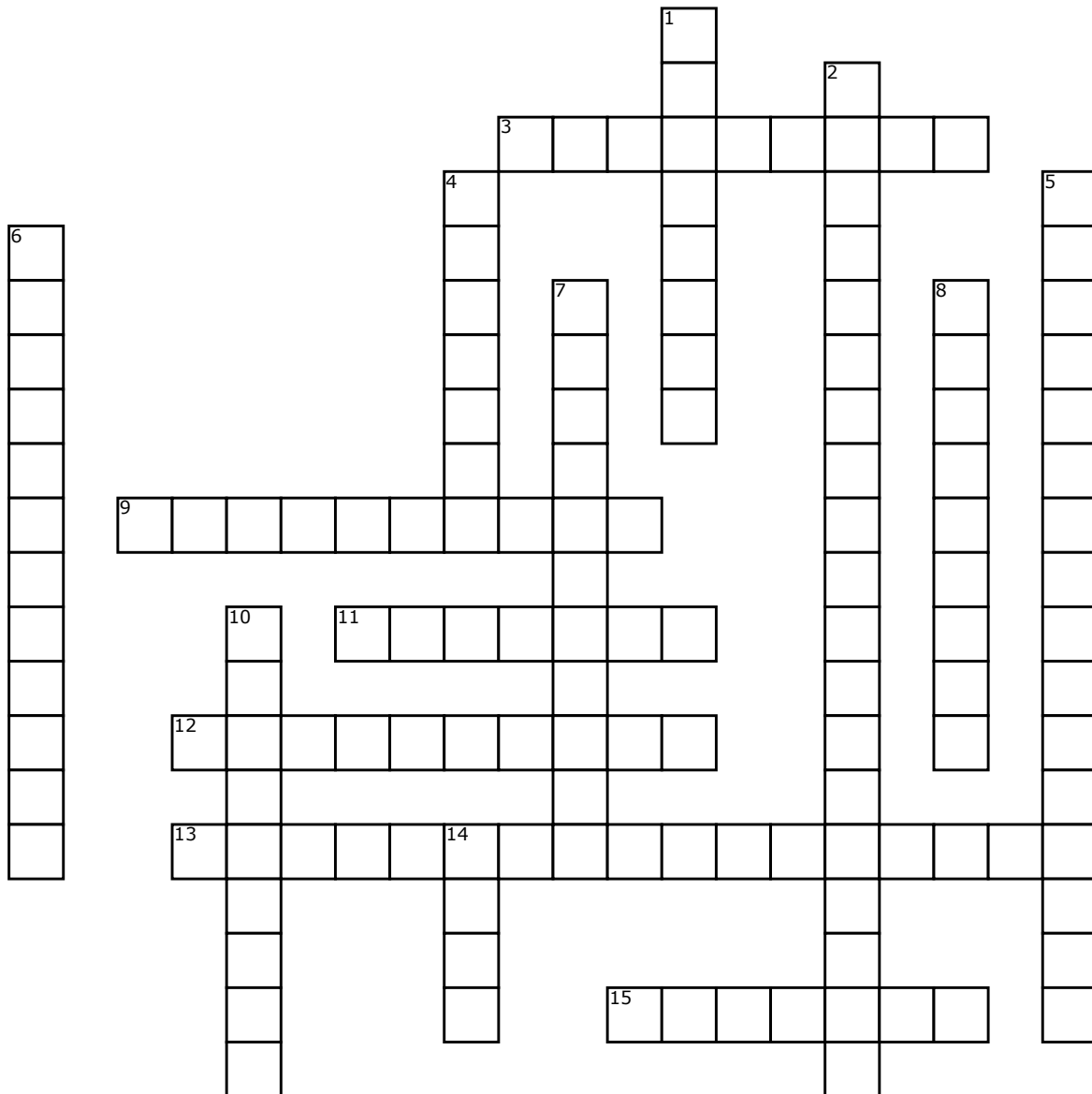


Science Fair Guidelines

- 9.** This statement predicts what you think will be the result of the experiment
- 11.** The information that you have gathered about your project
- 12.** This is what the judges will read to see if you understand what you observed in your lab
- 13.** The variable that you will be measuring in your experiment

15. This is the written out section that explains what your charts, data tables, pictures, photos, and graphs show

- 1.** A summarized version of your entire project
- 2.** The variable that you will be testing in your experiment
- 4.** A statement that describes exactly what the experiment is investigating in the form of a question

- 6.** This is a list of all of the sources of information that you used to write your report and complete your experiment
- 7.** A description of what can be learned from the experiment and its results
