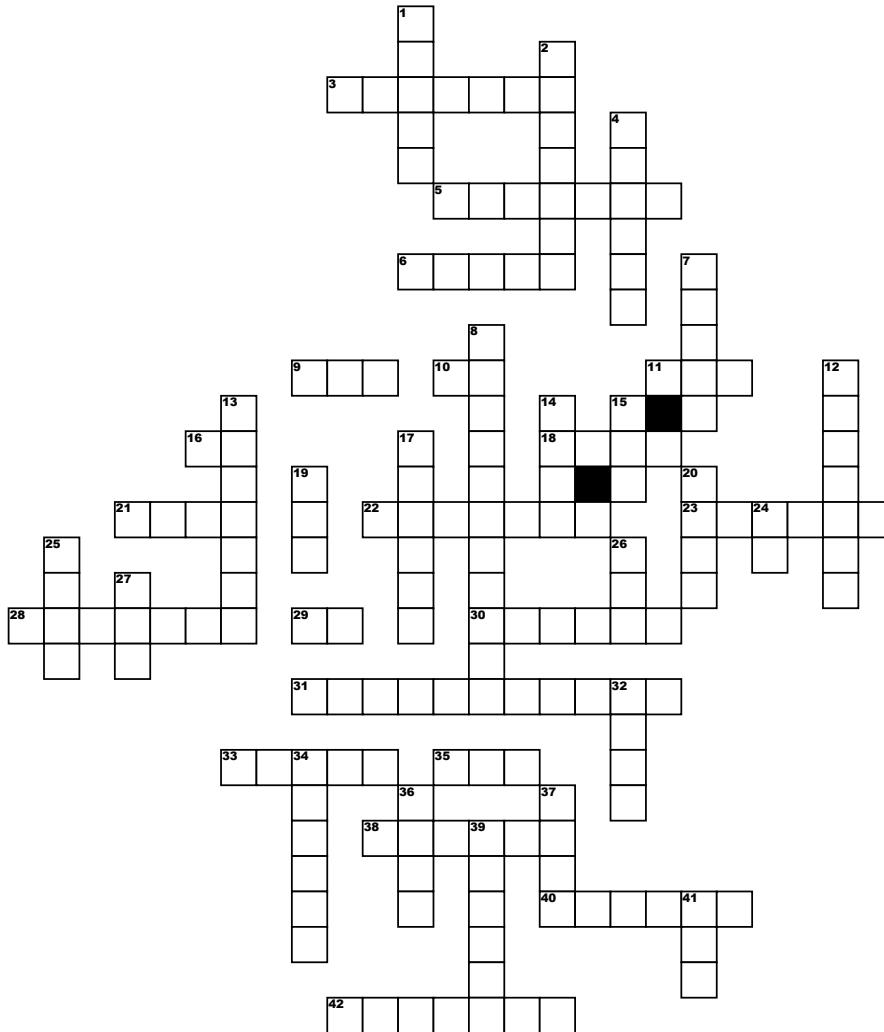


Scriptural puzzle
