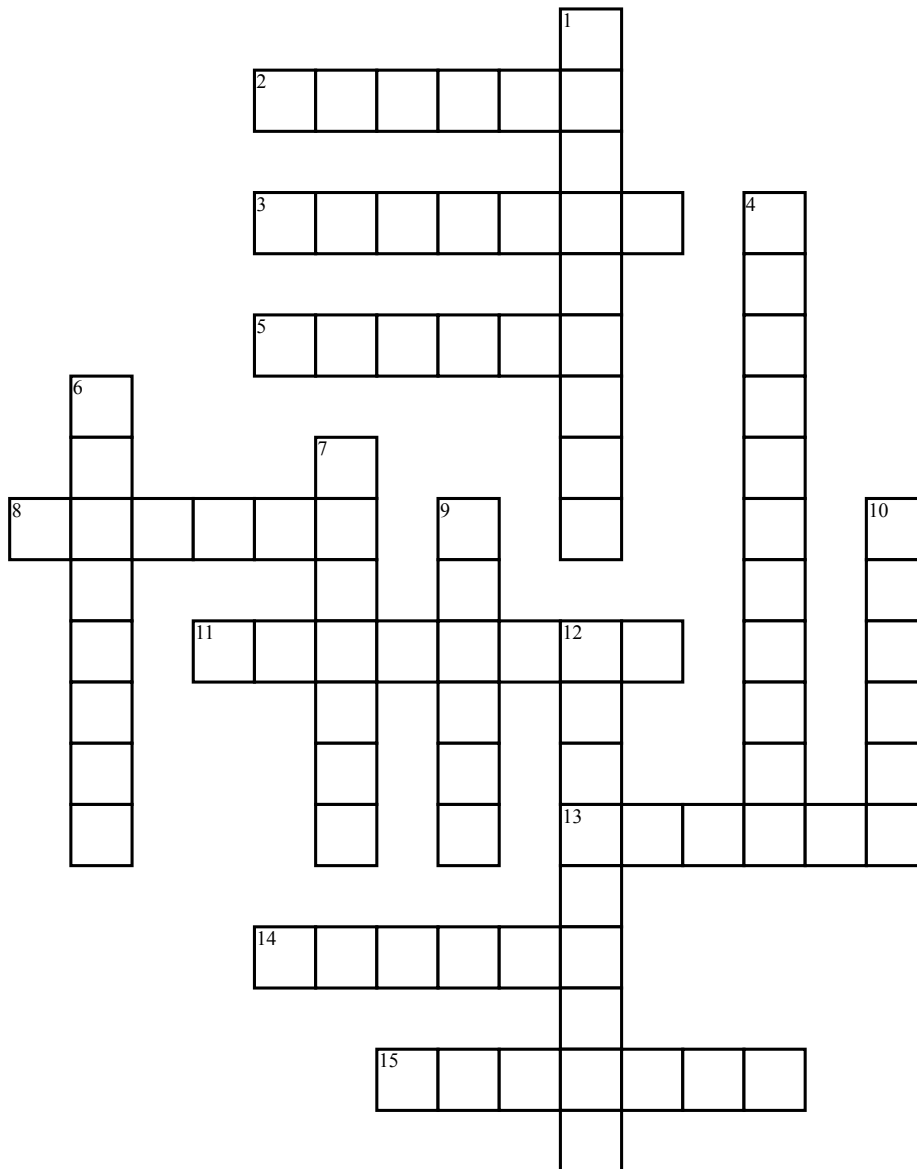


Sephardi Vocabulary Cross Word Puzzle
