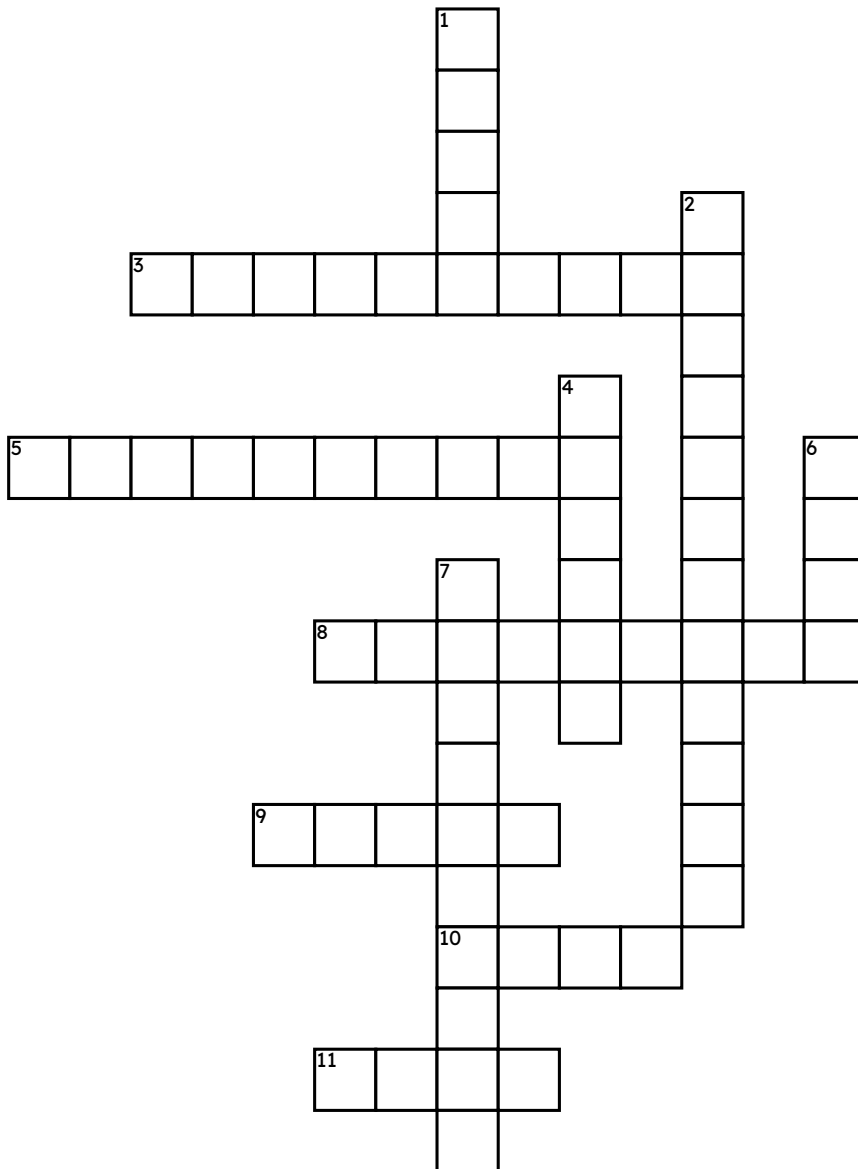


Sewing Crossword- Beginner



Across

- 3.** One warp yarn and two weft yarns create this type of double cloth that features two faces or "right" sides
- 5.** The ability of a fiber to take in moisture. Fibers can either be Hydrophilic or Hydrophobic
- 8.** The most basic seam; any seam that attaches two pieces of wrong facing fabrics together
- 9.** To lift and lower an iron onto pattern pieces to release wrinkles or to set in the seam
- 10.** To move the iron backward or forward against a finished garment in order to create crisp seams and help the garment lay correctly
- 11.** The front (or right) side of fabric

Down

- 1.** The way that the fabric falls and forms to the body
- 2.** Special needle designed for use in a sewing machine rather than for hand sewing
- 4.** The process of adding color to yarns, fabric or garments
- 6.** To cut down the sewn seam allowance to reduce bulk
- 7.** Reverse machine stitching done to the beginning and the end of a seam to secure the stitch from unraveling
