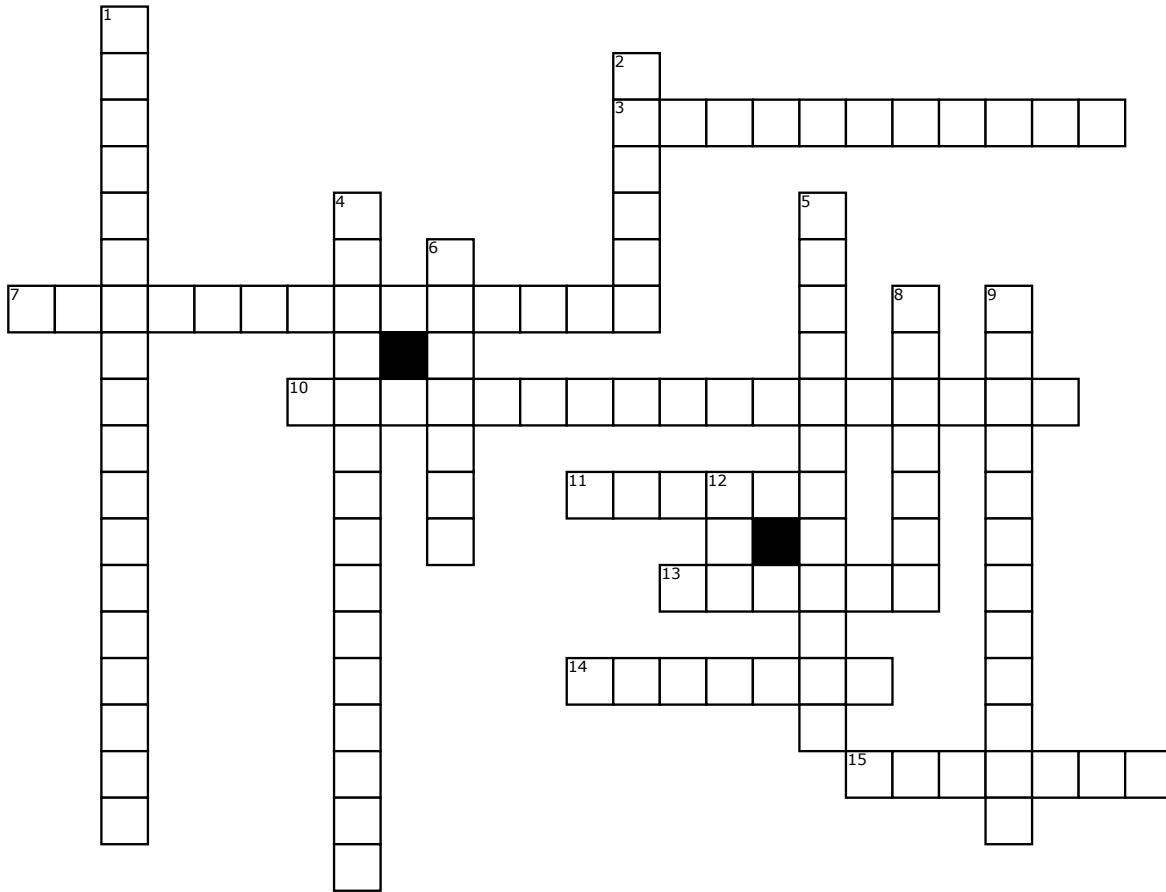


Shakespeare Crossword
