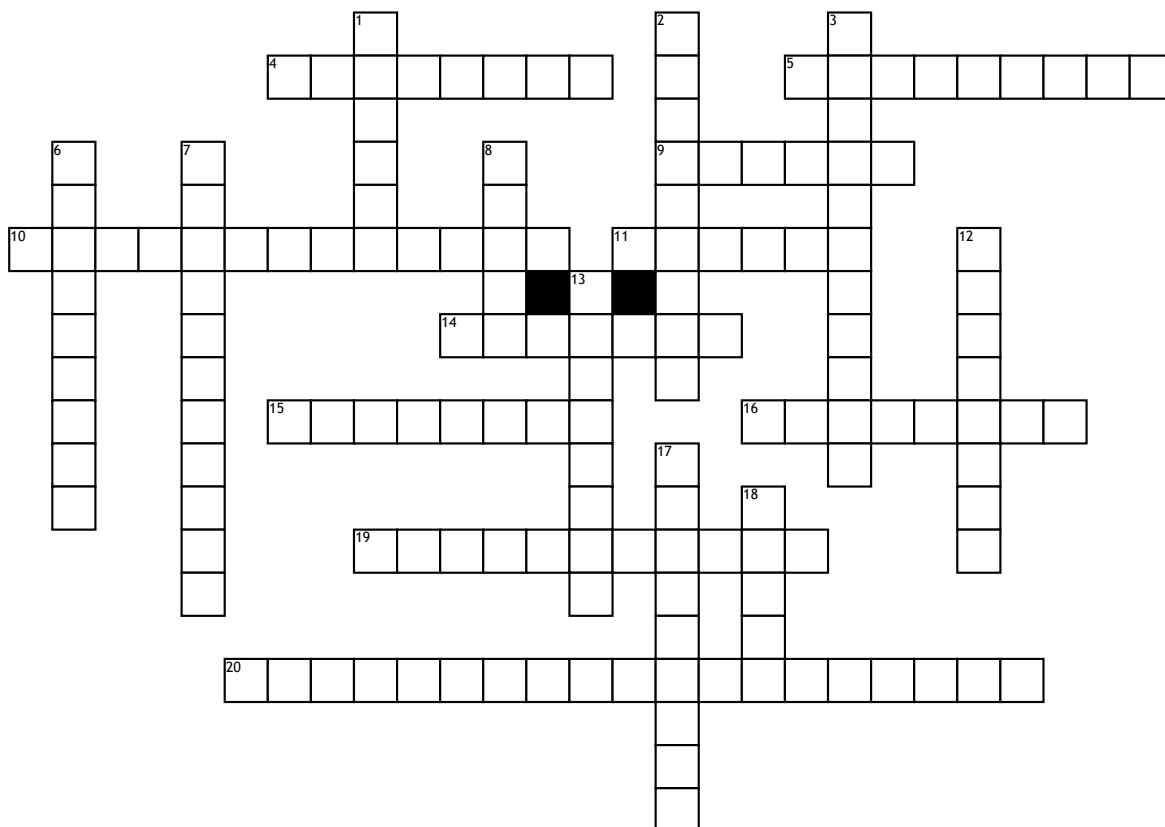


Shark Terms

- 4. Incurrent water passage for respiration
- 5. Tail fin
- 9. Filters blood and gets rid of old red blood cells
- 10. For smelling
- 11. Opening for urinary fluids, reproductive fluids, and waste
- 14. The single fin located directly behind the anus
- 15. Muscles in sharks

16. Produce enzyme to aid digestion

- 19. Fin used to keep shark afloat
- 20. Sensory structures used to detect electrical impulses, changes in temp., and salinity

- 1. Filters urine from blood
- 2. Fin(s) located on top of shark
- 3. Used to feel vibrations in water

6. A pair of fins located on the back underside of a fish

- 7. Removes salt to keep salt levels balanced
- 8. Large intestine
- 12. Portions of small intestine where most digestion occurs
- 13. Male reproductive organs
- 17. Main respiratory organs; used for water intake
- 18. Large organ helps the shark stay buoyant
