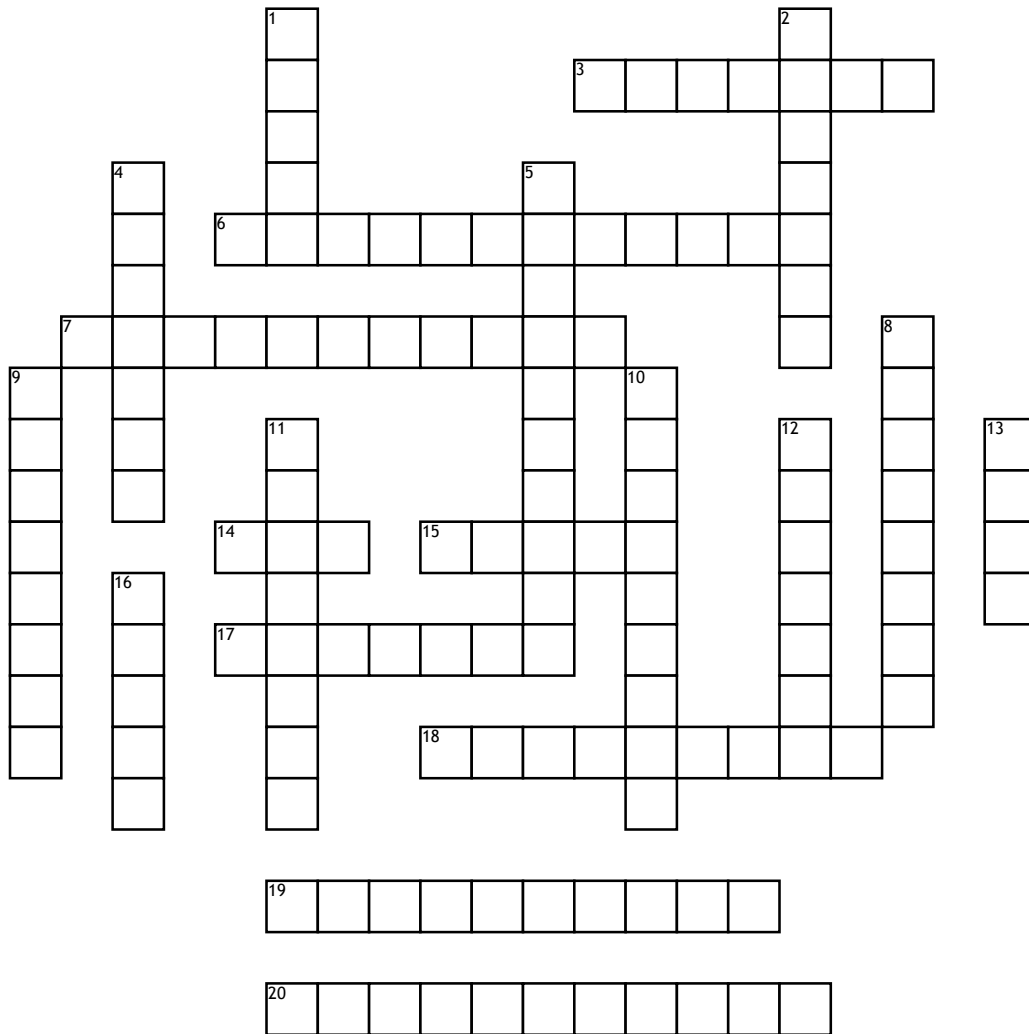


Sharks and Other Scary Sea Creatures

- 8. small organisms that drift in the water
- 9. an opening behind the eyes of a shark or a ray through which it can take in water to breathe

- 13. this part of an eye is colored and surrounds the pupil
