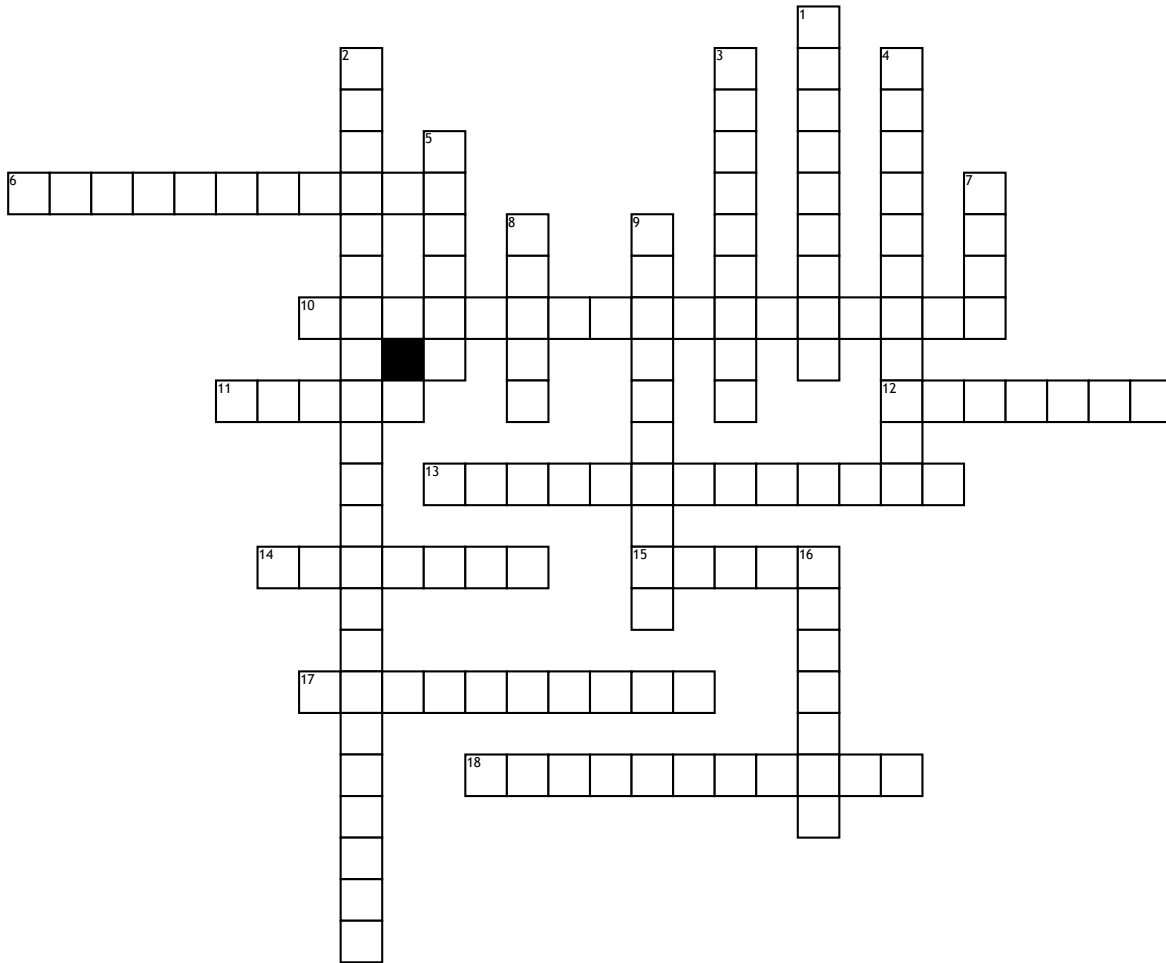


Short Story Elements
