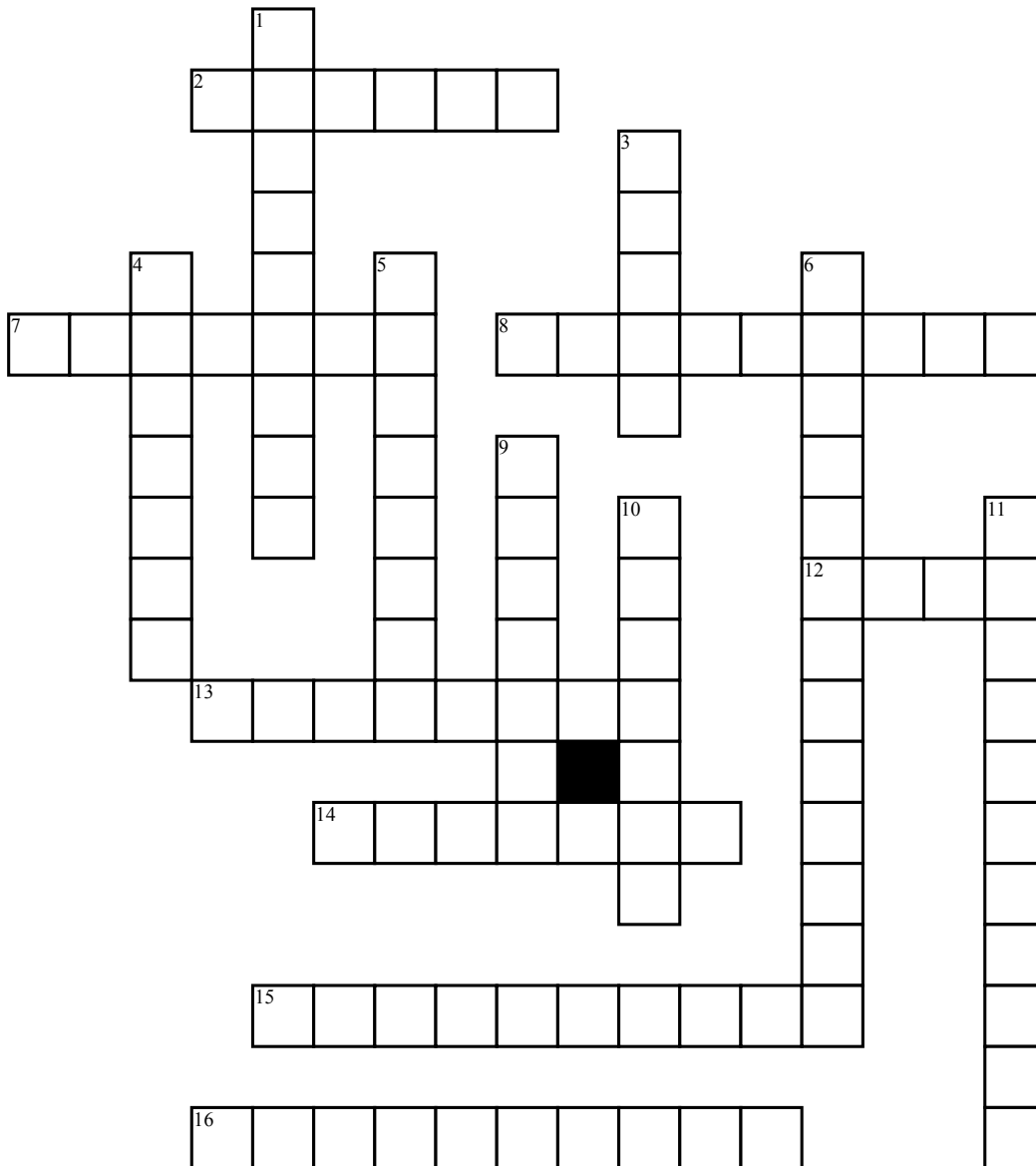


# Signs & Symptoms of the Nervous System

2. Lack of coordination.  
 7. Rhythmic, quivering, purposeless skeletal muscle movements.  
 8. Difficulty with swallowing.  
 12. Deep, prolonged unconsciousness from which the patient cannot be aroused.  
 13. Localized collection of blood in an organ, tissue or space.  
 14. Loss of memory caused by brain damage or severe emotional trauma.

15. Neuromuscular reaction to abnormal electrical activity within the brain.  
 16. Serious head injury characterized by one or more of the following: LOC, amnesia, seizures, or a change in mental status.  
**Down**  
 1. Continuous, involuntary, slow, writhing movement of the extremities.  
 3. Involuntary muscle contraction of sudden onset.  
 4. Dizziness

5. Weakness  
 6. Involuntary contraction of small, local muscles  
 9. Fainting  
 10. Lack or impairment of the ability to form or understand speech.  
 11. Feeling of prickling, burning or numbness.
