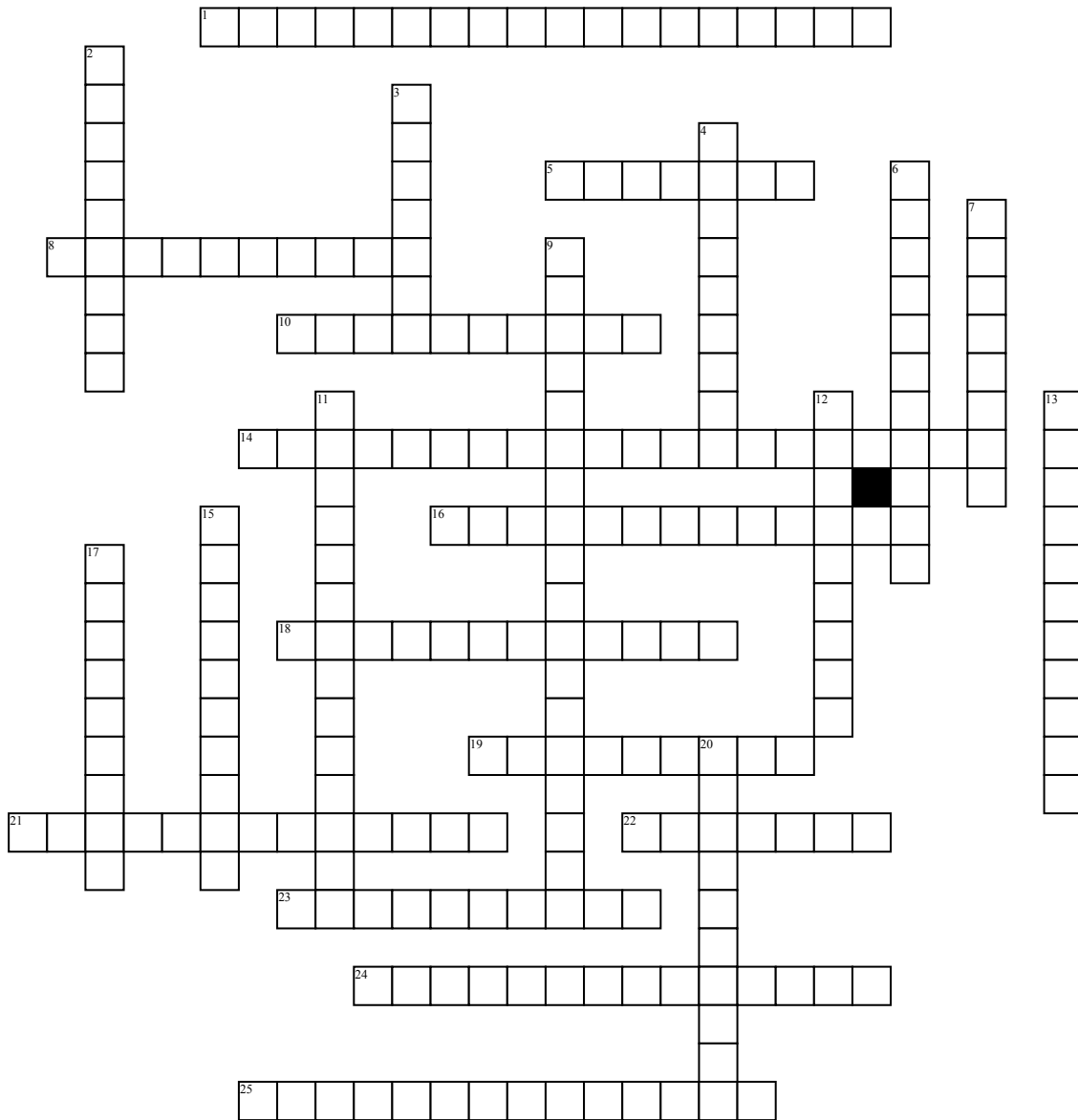


# Skeletal System

1. occurs within the marrow cavities of certain bones

18. cavity of the shaft is primarily a storage area for adipose tissue

## 22. storehouse

23. a fibrous connective tissue membrane
24. are bones that do not fit with long, short, or flat bones
25. Includes the bones, joints, cartilages, and ligaments (fibrous cords that bind the bones together at joints).

2. cavity of shaft where blood cells are formed in infants
3. tiny cavities found within the matrix
4. mostly compact, long than wide, and have shaft heads at both ends
6. hundreds of connective tissue fibers

7. \_\_\_\_ is the result of using the bones as levers to move the body and its parts
9. covers external surfaces; instead of periosteum
11. a flat plate of hyaline cartilage
12. thin, flattened, and usually curved (bones)
13. is dense, smooth and homogenous
15. cube shaped and contain mostly spongy bones
17. (or shaft) makes up most of the bones length and composed of compact bones
20. composed of small needle-like pieces of bones and lots of open space
