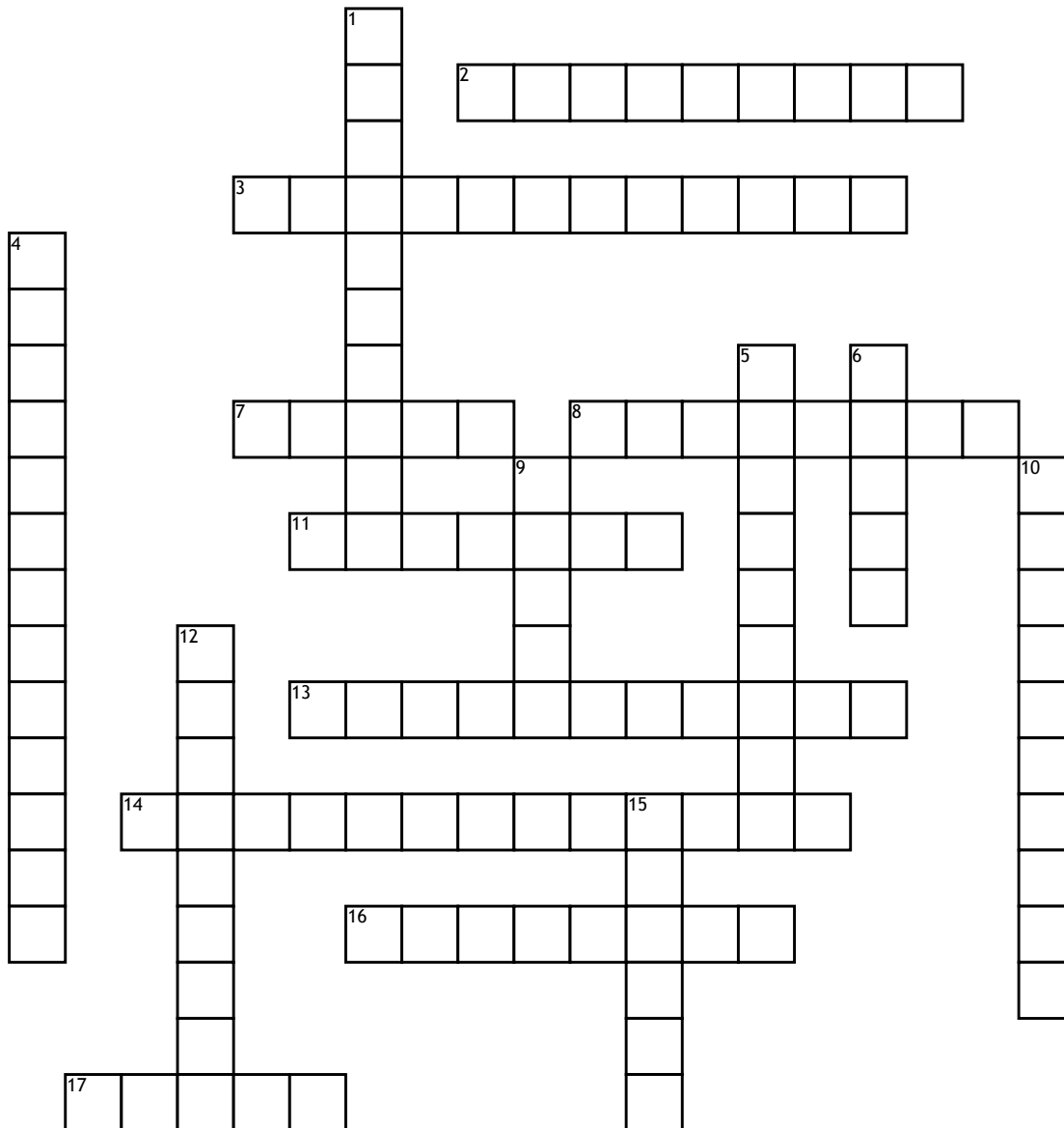

 3. This is the process of laying down minerals to turn cartilage into bone
 7. The fluid filled sac that reduces friction in a synovial joint
 8. Bones found in a tendon e.g. patella

13. The area where bones grow in length
 14. A joint with a large range of movement e.g. pelvis and femur
 16. Also known as the collar bone
 17. A shallow dip in a bone

 4. Joints allowing small amount of movement e.g. vertebrae

5. This protects friction and grinding at the ends of bones
 6. An indentation in the bone
 9. A joint found in the neck between the atlas and axis, allowing rotational movement
