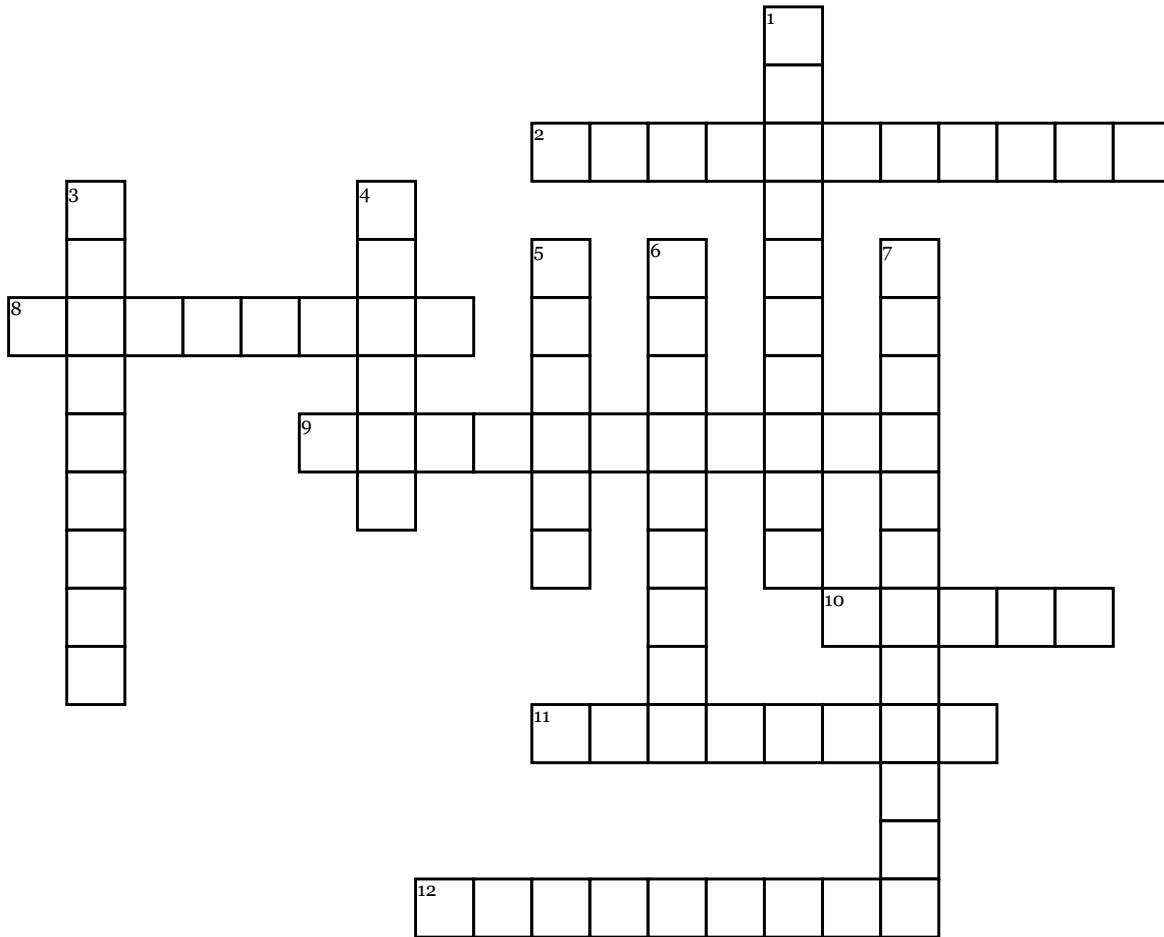


# Skeletal System

**2.** When the end of a bone comes out of its joint.

**8.** A break in the body.

**9.** A hard and dense but, not solid layer of bone under the outer membrane.

**10.** A place in the body where two bones come together.

**11.** The inner framework made up of all the bones in the body.

**12.** A strong connective tissue that holds together the bones in movable joints.

## Down

**1.** Layer of bone tissue having many small faces and found just under the compact bone.

**3.** The 26 small bones that make up the backbone.

**4.** The soft connective tissue that fills the internal spaces in bone.

**5.** When ligaments are stretched too far and tear in places.

**6.** A type of connective tissue that keeps bones from rubbing against each other.

**7.** A condition in which the bones are weak and break easily.
