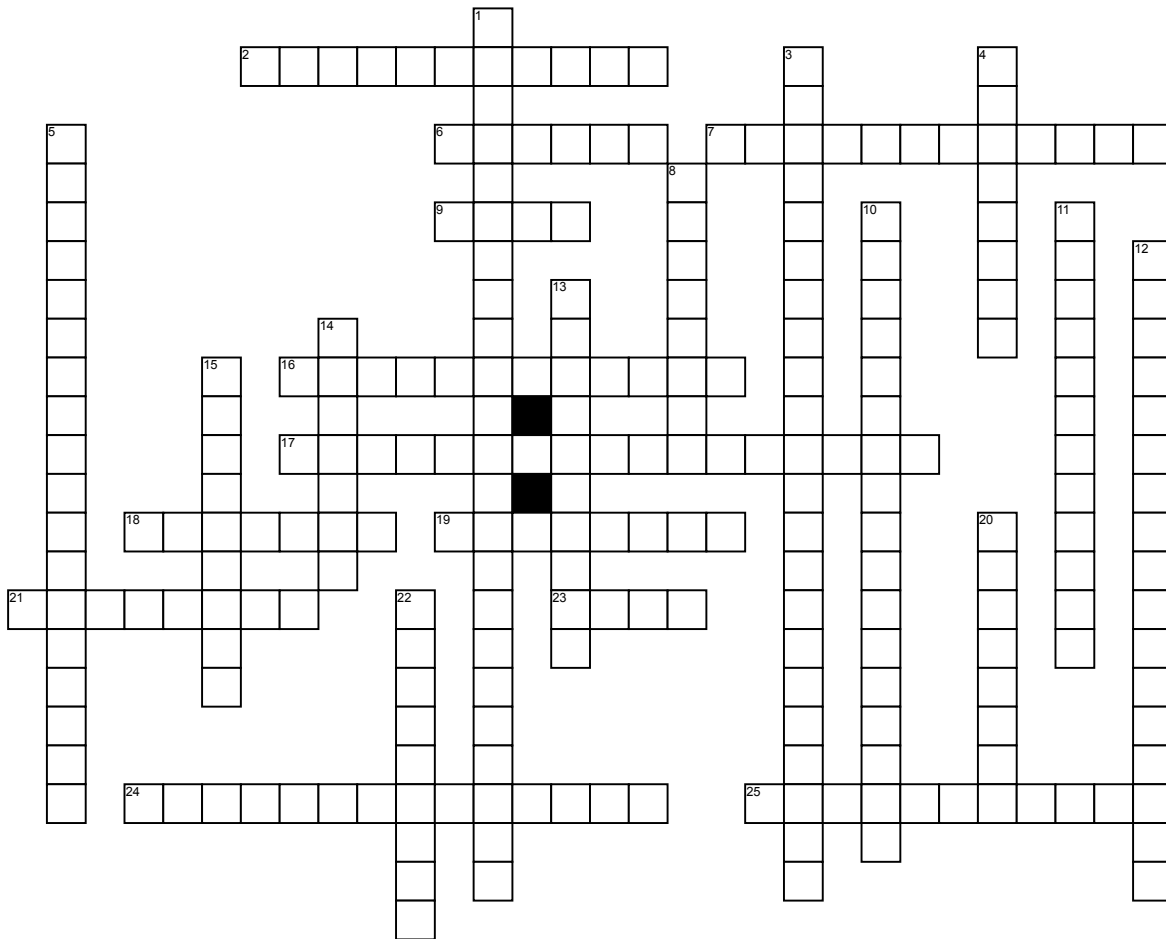


# Skeletal System 5



## **Across**

- 2.** vertebral canal continues inside the sacrum  
**6.** formed from the fusion of 3-5 irregular shaped vertebrae  
**7.** where the manubrium and body meet at a slight angle  
**9.** 12 bone parts  
**16.** is the level of the 3rd thoracic vertebrae  
**17.** midpoint of the shaft is roughened area  
**18.** breastbone  
**19.** enlarged end of the spine

- 21.** first 7 pairs attached to the sternum

- 23.** forms posterior wall of pelvis  
**24.** aka pectoral girdle  
**25.** shallow socket that receives the head of the arm bone

## **Down**

- 1.** connected to the acromion  
**3.** sites of muscle attachment  
**4.** shoulder blades  
**5.** serves as the nerve pathway  
**8.** collarbone

- 10.** point where sternal body and xiphoid process fuse  
**11.** large inferior opening  
**12.** posterior midline of pelvis surface  
**13.** are made up by sternum, ribs, & thoracic cage  
**14.** arm single long bone  
**15.** the 5 rib pairs attached indirectly to the sternum  
**20.** beaklike  
**22.** body result of fusion from 3 bones
