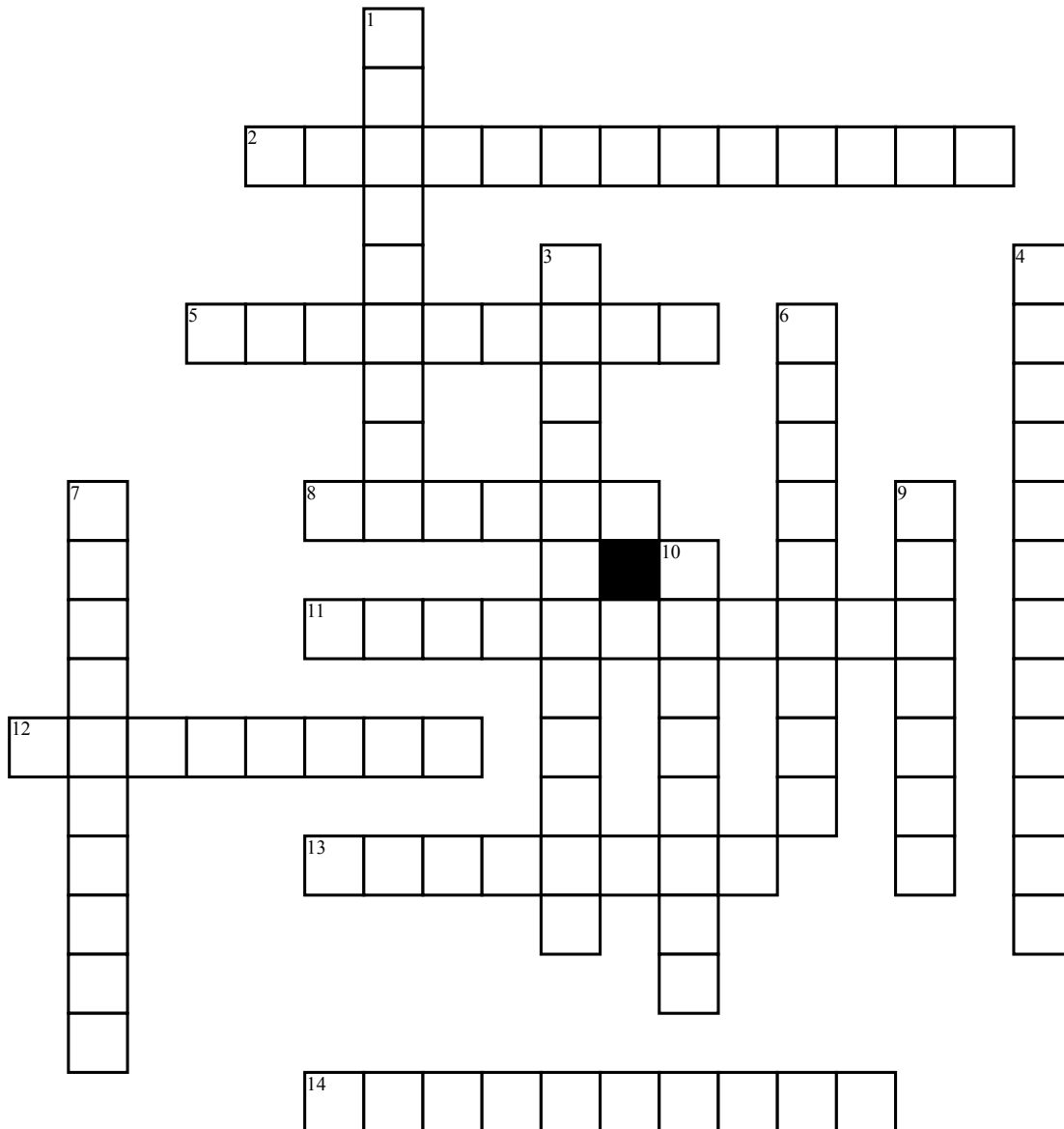


Skeletal System



Across

- 2. sharp blow to a joint or a severe twisting of a joint
- 5. a lateral or side-to-side curvature of the spine
- 8. fibrous cord that attaches muscle to the bone
- 11. when a bone slips out of place, tearing the ligaments that attach the bone at the joint

- 12. band of fibrous, slightly elastic connective tissue that attaches one bone to another
- 13. painful inflammation of bursa
- 14. when the fracture is completely across the bone

Down

- 1. strong, flexible connective tissue
- 3. a condition in which there is a progressive loss of bone tissue

- 4. process by which bone is formed, renewed, repaired
- 6. inflammation of a joint
- 7. when the bone shatters into more than two pieces
- 9. painful swelling of the bursae in the first joints of big toes
- 10. if part of the bone do not separate
