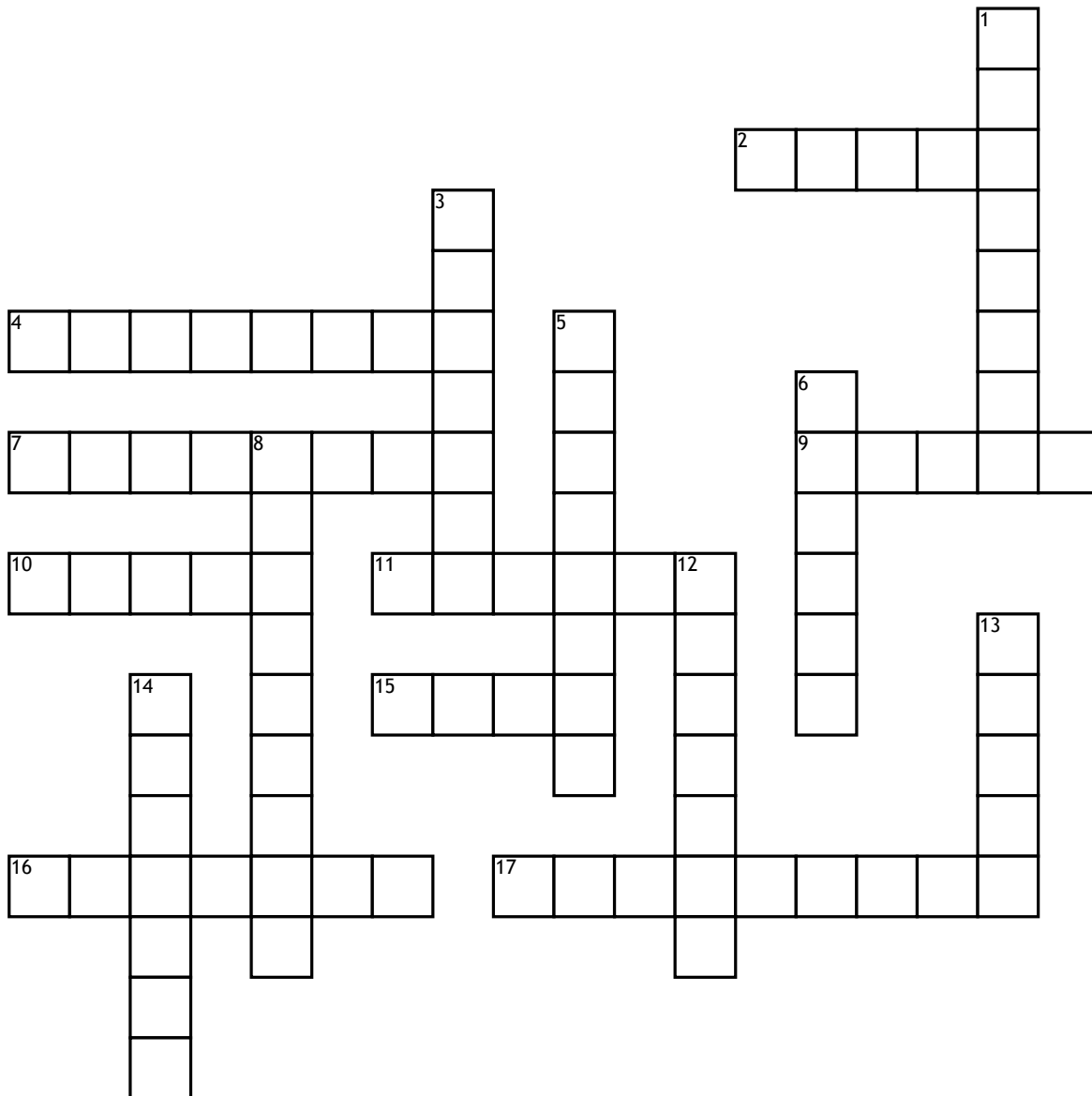


Skeletal Terminology

2. Second largest bone in the body, also in the leg
 4. A short band of tough connective tissue that connects bones or cartilages together
 7. Joints that contain fluid that lubricates the joint
 9. Latin prefix meaning "related to the bone"
 10. The largest bone in the body

11. One of the bones in the forearm that runs from the elbow to the thumb side of the wrist
 15. One of two bones in the forearm, it is the larger one
 16. 8 small bones that make up the wrist
 17. The 14 bones that make up the fingers

Down

1. Collarbone
 3. Knee cap
 5. The 7 vertebrae found in the neck

6. Small, triangular bone located at the bottom of the spine. Resembles a tailbone.
 8. Bones that form a tunnel to protect the spinal cord
 12. Shoulder blade
 13. Cartilage pads between the vertebrae that absorb shock.
 14. Flat bone that connects to the ribs via cartilage and forms the front of the rib cage.
