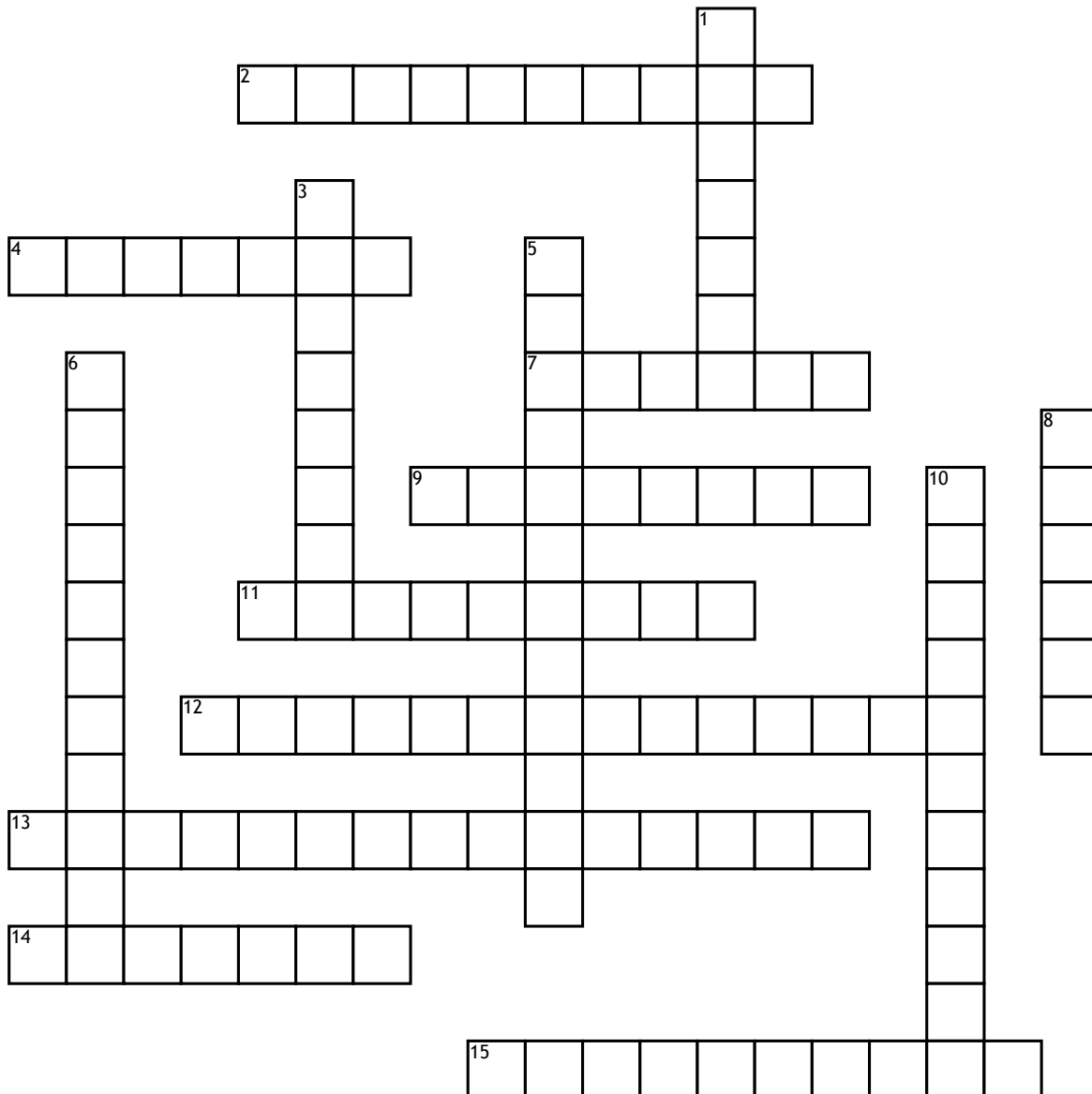


Skeletal Terms
