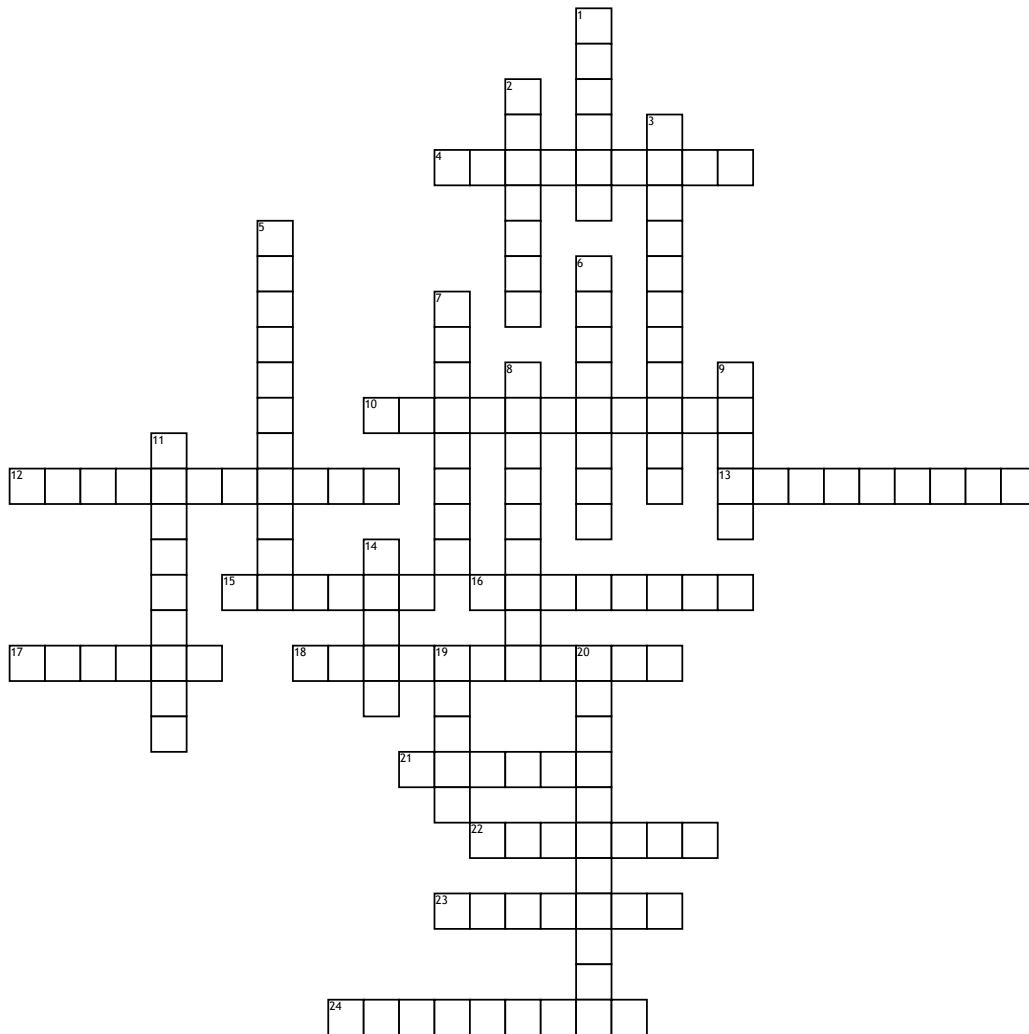


Skeleton Creek Vocabulary Crossword
