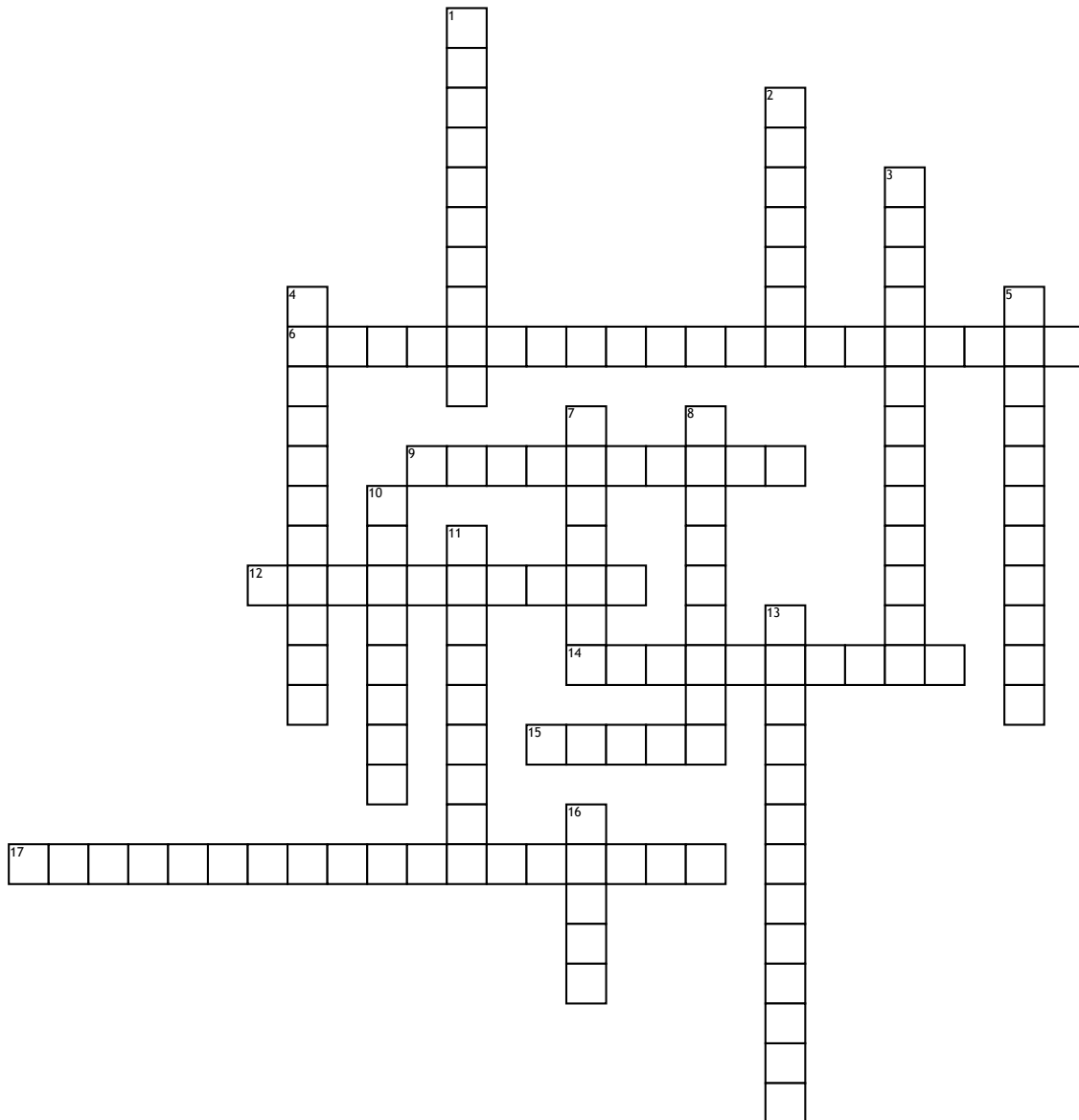


Skeleton & Muscles Crossword
