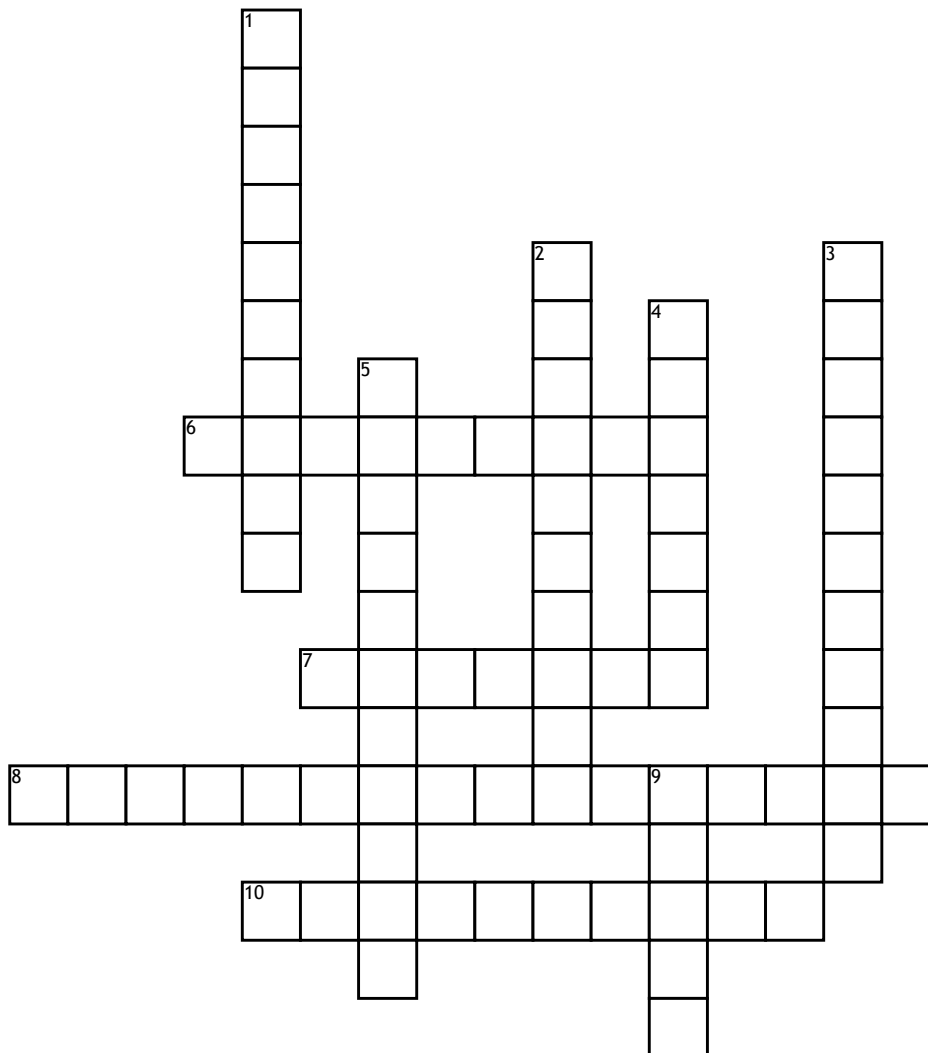


# Skeleton & Muscles



## Across

6. Bands of tough, flexible tissue that hold bones in a joint together.
7. Tissues that attach muscle to bones and holds the muscles in position.
8. One bone has a ball shaped surface that fits in a socket of another bone.
10. Joint that only moves backwards and forwards.

## Down

1. A ring shaped bone turning around a finger typed bone.
2. It is light yet, it provides a strong inner structure to the bone.
3. Makes up the outer layer of a bone.
4. Tissues that are able to contract and stretched.
5. Allows movement in two directions.
