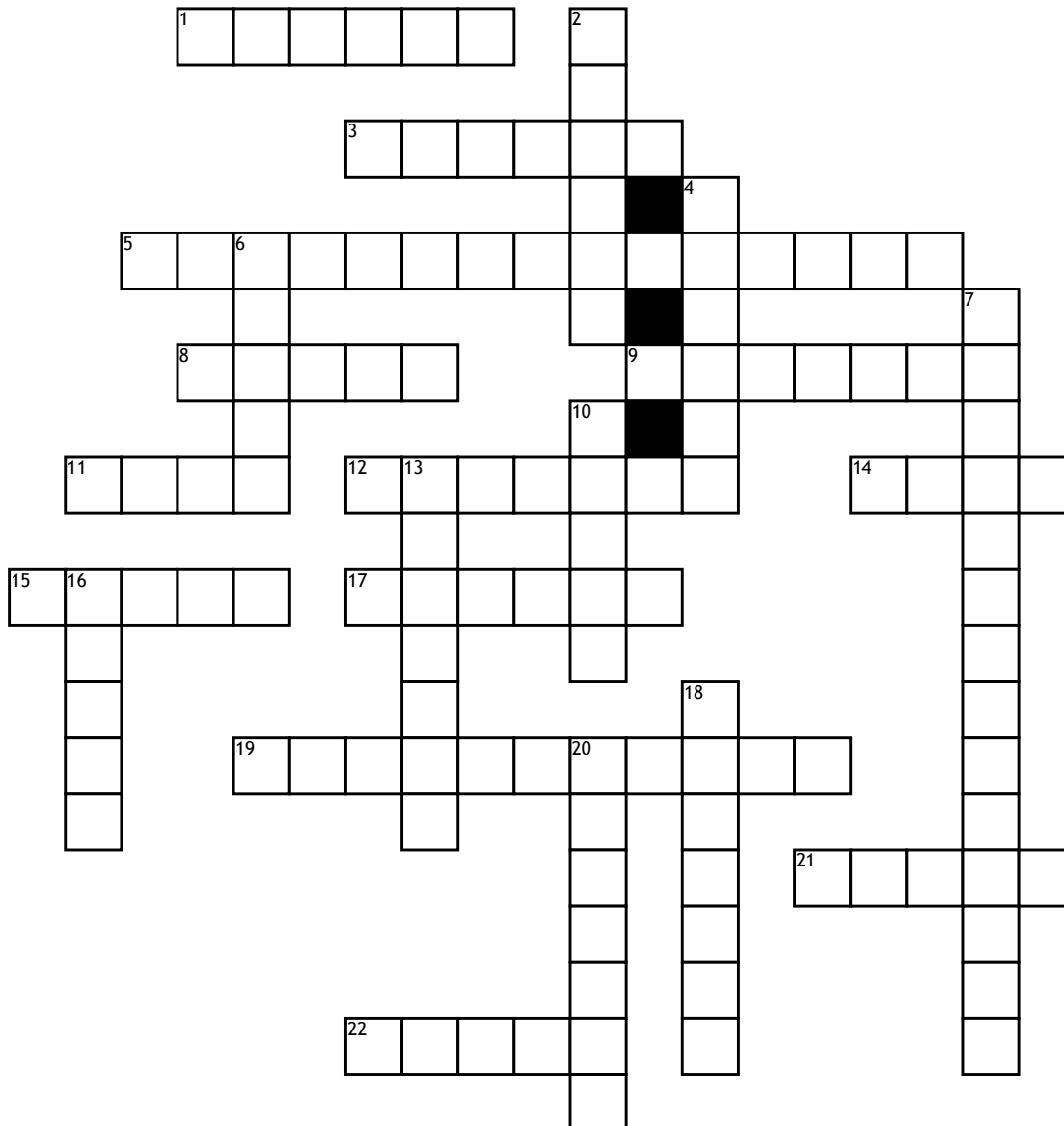


Skin Lesions



Across

1. Primary; Elevated firm rough greater than 1 cm
3. Primary, Flat circumscribed less than 1 cm
5. Secondary; Rough thickened skin due to itching
8. Primary; Vesicle greater than 1 cm
9. Primary; Elevated with purulent fluid
11. Primary; Encapsulated Lesion
12. Primary; Superficial elevated lesion filled with serous fluid

14. Secondary; Thick fibrous tissue that replaced skin after injury
 15. Primary; Elevated solid lesion deeper in dermis greater than 2 cm
 17. Primary; 1-2 cm elevated firm lesion; Deeper in dermis
 19. Secondary; loss of epidermis
 21. Primary; Elevated irregular insect bite
 22. Primary; Flat non palpable, irregular

2. Secondary; Irregular shaped enlarging scar

4. Primary, Elevated, firm circumscribed less than 1 cm
6. Secondary; dried serum, blood, pus exudates
7. Primary; irregular lines via capillary dilation
10. Secondary; flaky skin
13. Secondary; Loss of part of epidermis following a rupture
16. Secondary; loss of epidermis and dermis
18. Secondary; linear crack in epidermis
20. Secondary; thinning of skin surface and loss of skin markings
