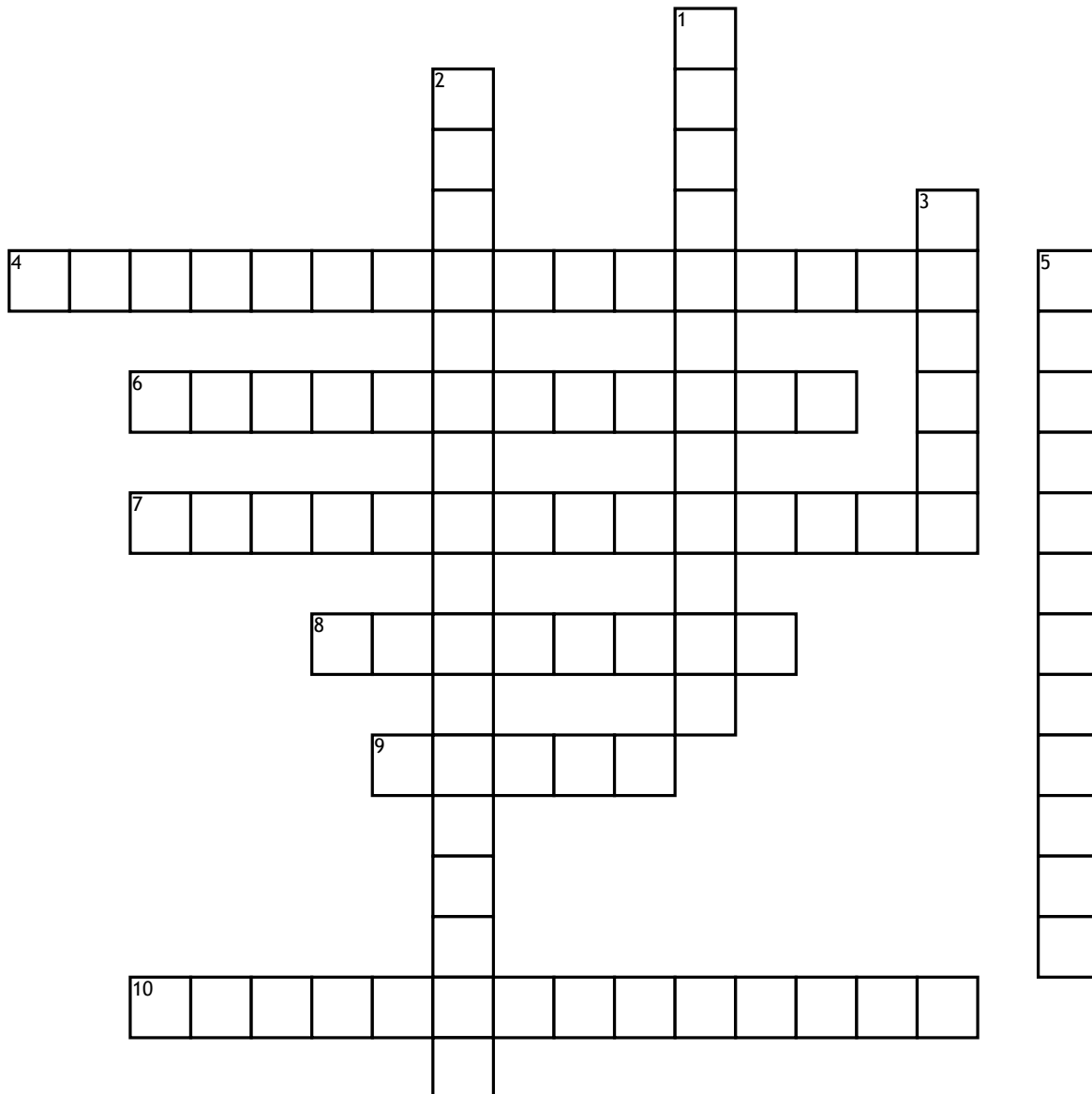


Skin markings



Across

4. Connects, supports, binds, or separates other tissues or organs
6. Skin is marked by many lines, creases and ridges
7. Markings on fingertips characteristic of primates
8. Flat melanized patches vary with heredity or exposure to sun
9. Elevated patch of melanized skin, of the with hair mostly harmless, beauty marks

10. Antigen presenting immune cells

Down

1. Skin is tightly bound to deep fascia at these points
2. During embryonic development thousands of small groups of epidermal cells from stratum basale push down into dermis to form hair follicles and glands
3. Thick layer of living tissue
5. Friction ridge skin impressions
