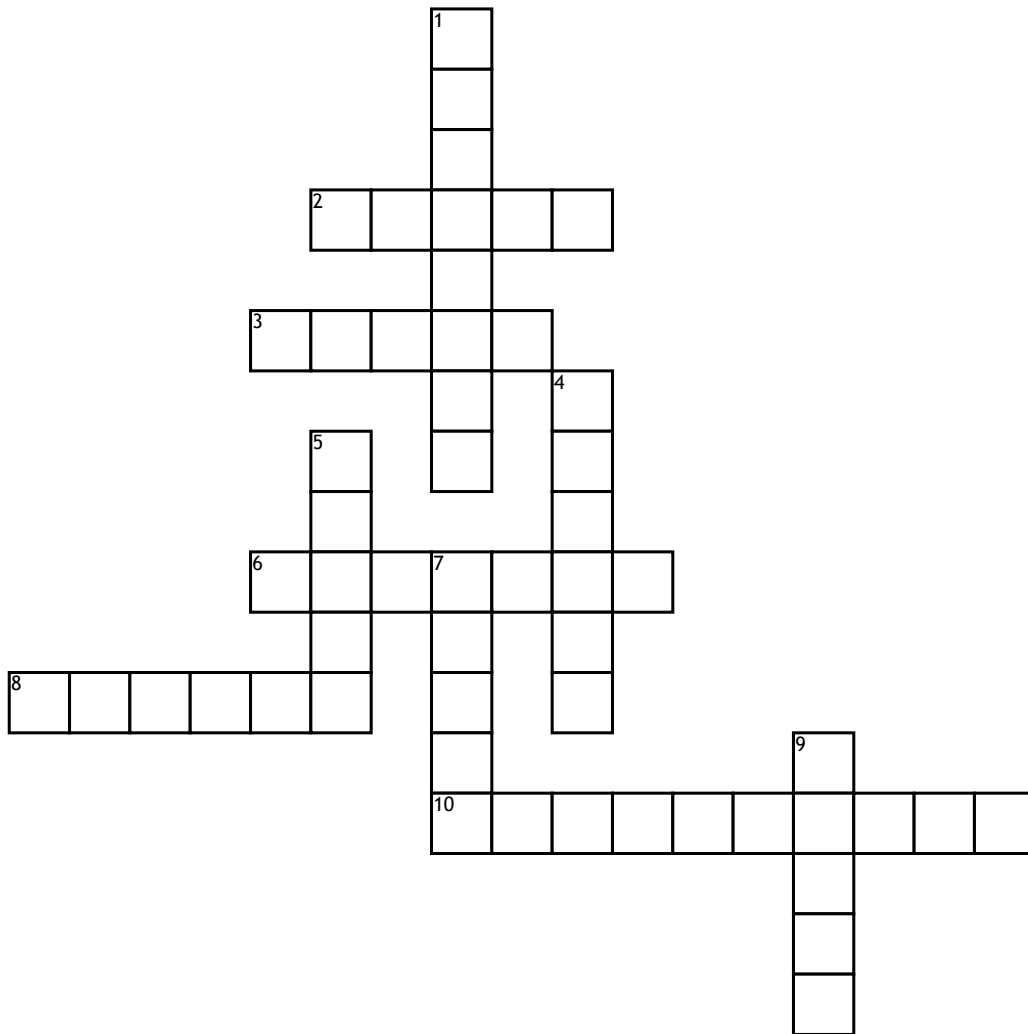


# Slopes



## Across

2. A near vertical slope, more than 80° to the horizontal
3. A slope represented with contour lines close to each other
6. On a map the Contour lines will be spaced closer with an increase in height above sea-level.
8. The contour lines of this slope spread far apart from each other
10. The study of the shape and features of land surfaces.

## Down

1. Is a low-angel concave slope.
4. A slope that becomes progressively steeper downhill
5. It is any geometric element of the Earth's surface
7. A small convex-shaped slope with a thin covering of soil
9. A slope with a constant angle, and is formed of eroded material from crest and freeface
