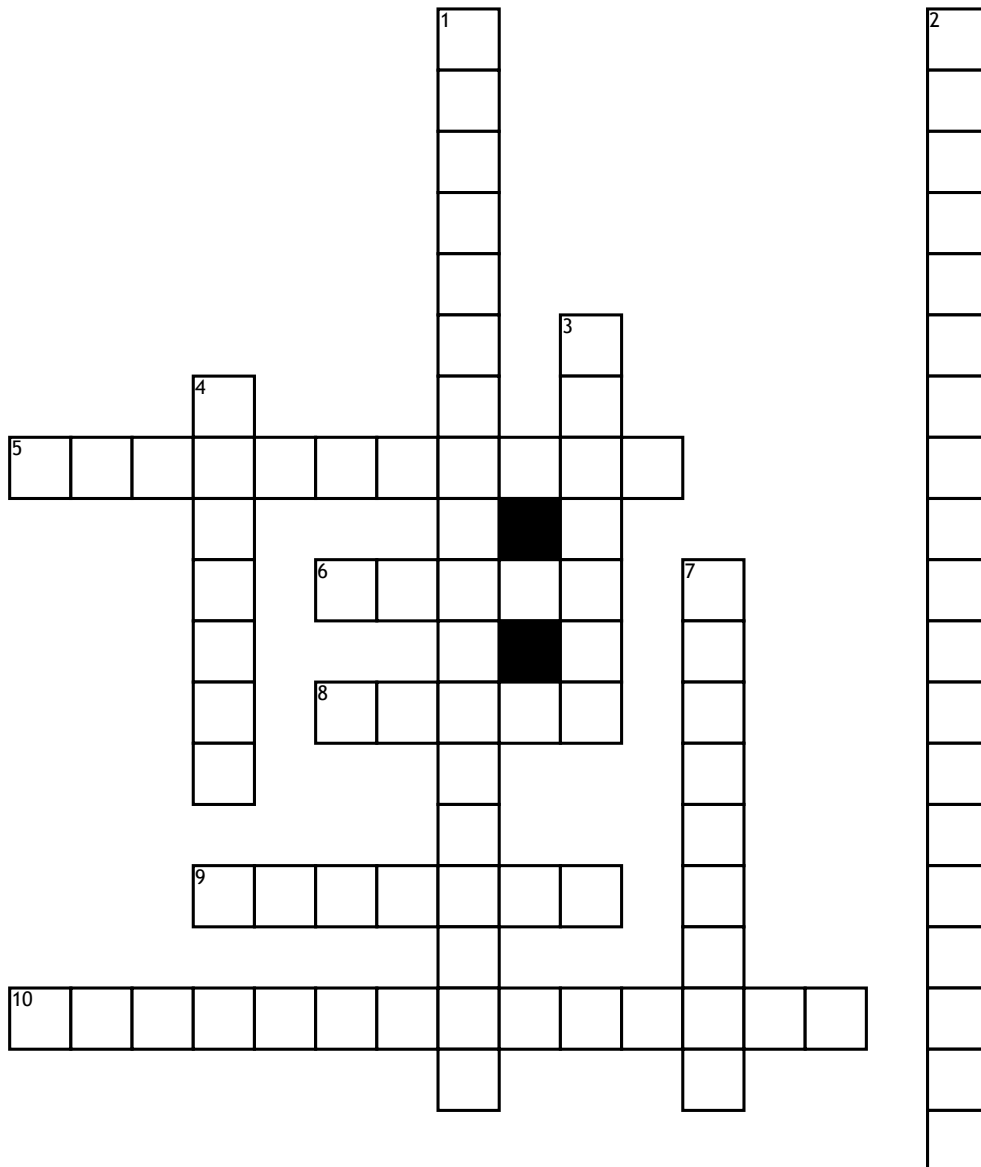

## Across

- 5. The upper part of the throat behind the nose.
- 6. Nostrils
- 8. A slimy substance secreted by mucous membranes.
- 9. Separates the nasal cavity from the mouth.
- 10. Receives neural input about odors.

## Down

- 1. Responsible for the detection of odors.

- 2. Thin tissue forming the outer layer of a body's surface and lining the alimentary canal.
- 3. Air-filled cavities that surround the nose.
- 4. Bones that extend down through the nasal cavity.
- 7. Chamber or channel communicating with or opening into another.
