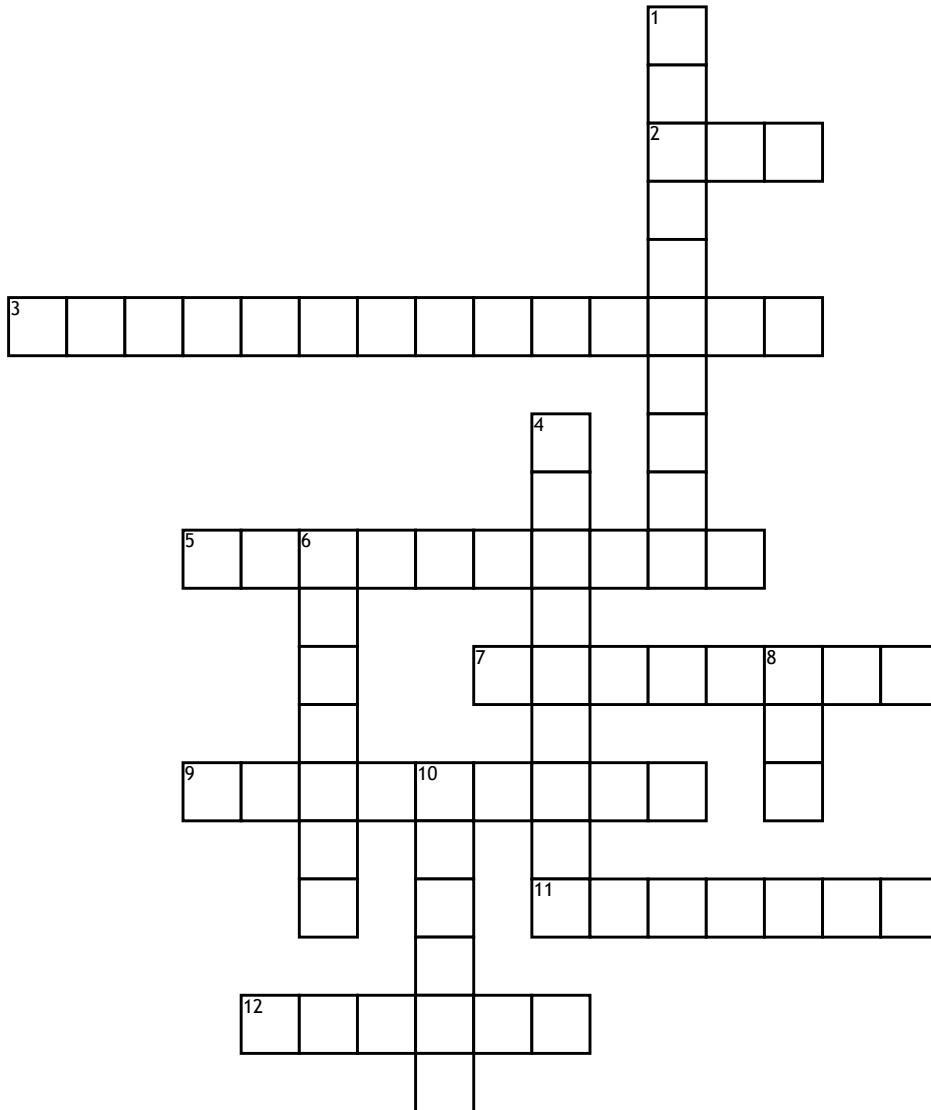


Smoking Cessation

2. First step ("A") to help a smoker quit.
3. binds to hemoglobin in blood instead of oxygen.
5. cigarettes contain 43 of these cancer-causing substances.
7. component in e-cigs that causes "popcorn lungs".

9. antidepressant given to help reduce nicotine cravings.

11. nicotine, mixed with base, coloring, flavoring, and chemicals.

12. step that involves asking the question if the patient is ready to quit or not.

1. builds in lungs with cigarette smoking.
4. medication originally used to treat hypertension.
6. Common within the first 8 days of quitting.
8. Coats the lungs with cigarette smoking.
10. oxidant gases mix with this substance.
