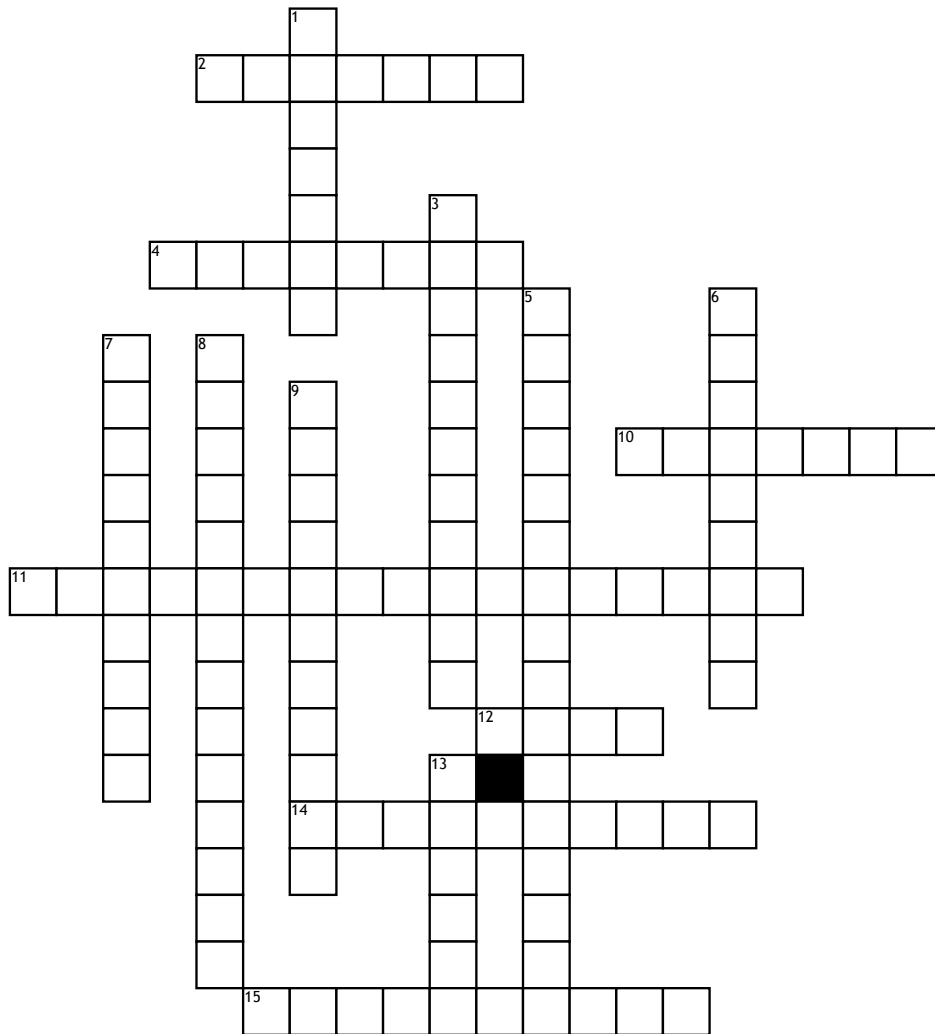

- 2. Technique used for restarting the game when the ball goes out of play over the sideline
- 4. The rectangular area in front of the goal where the ball is placed for a goal kick
- 10. The free kick that starts play at the beginning of the game, after each period, or after a score.
- 11. Trapping a ball and immediately repassing it
- 12. Technique used for receiving the ball, bringing it under control

- 14. A pass that is directed toward the side of a player
- 15. A direct free kick awarded to the attacking player on the corner arc when the defending team last played the ball over their own end line.

Down

- 1. A player maintaining control of the ball while moving from one spot to another.
- 3. A free kick awarded for a direct free kick foul in the penalty area against the defending team.

- 5. A free kick from which a player other than the kicker must contact the ball.
- 6. The sideline of the field
- 7. Contacting the ball just as it hits the ground after being airborne.
- 8. A free kick from which the kicker may immediately score from the initial contact.
- 9. A pass that penetrates between and past the defenders
- 13. Technique for taking the ball away from the opponent
