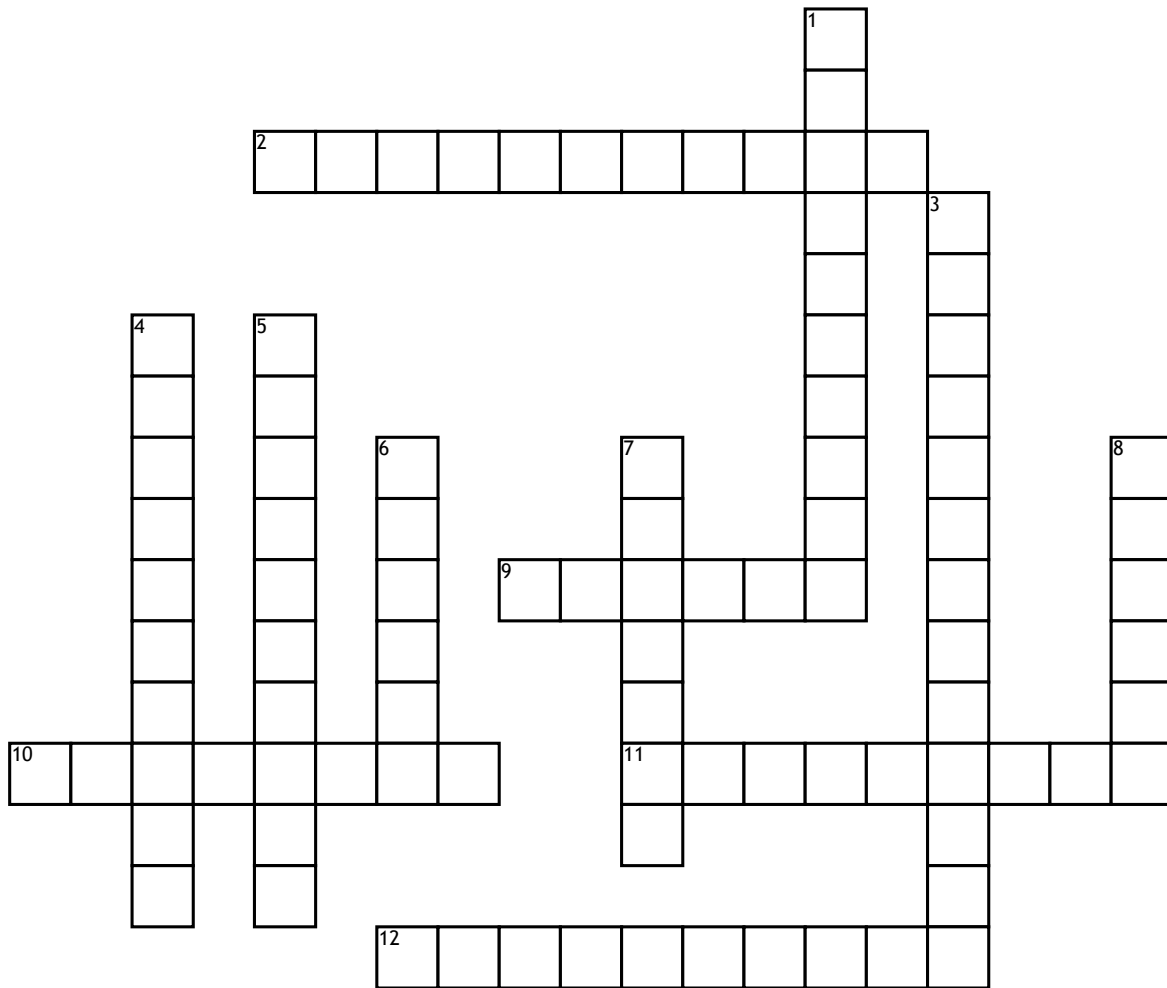


Social 8: World History Crossword
