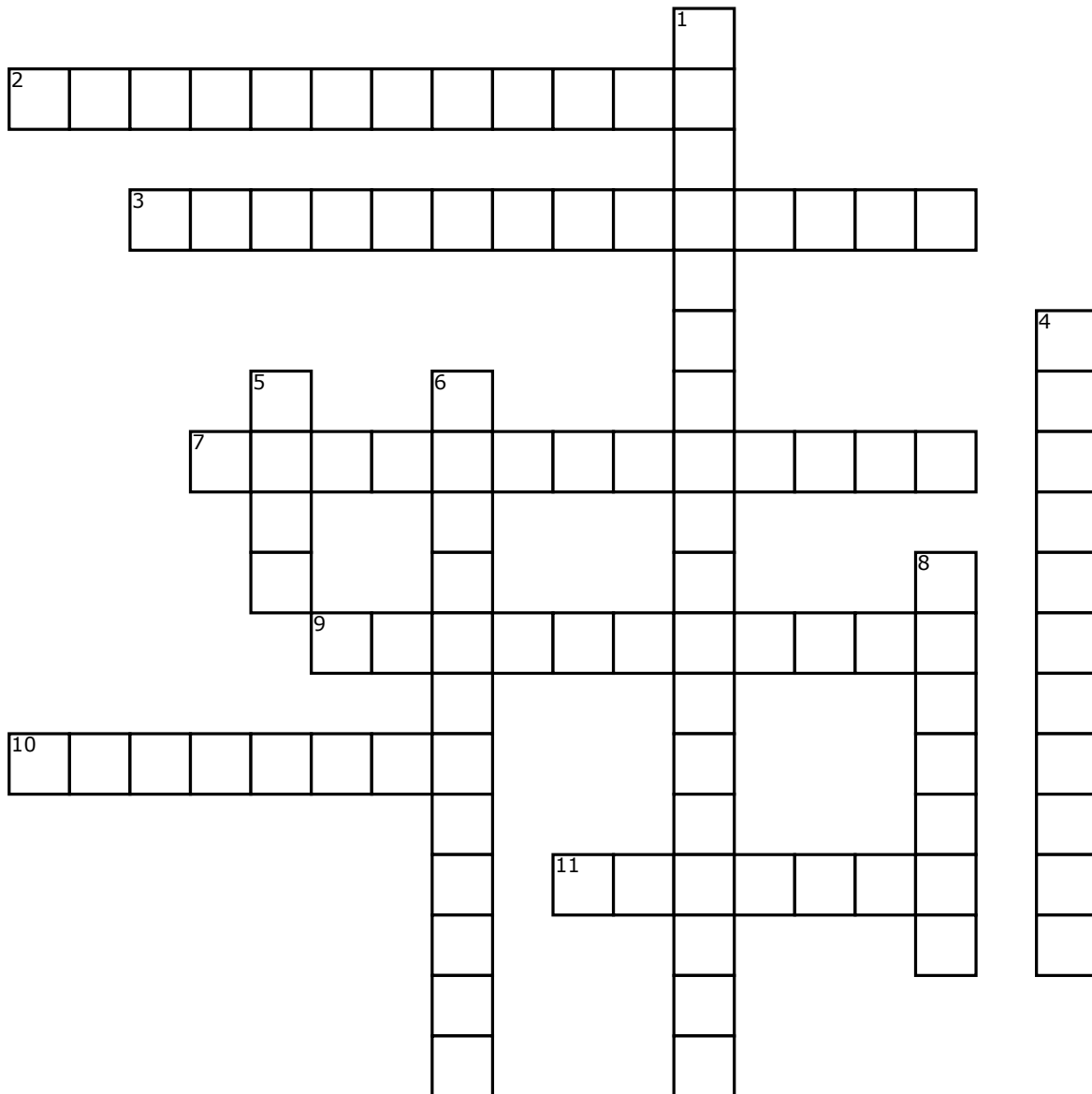


# Social Policy Crossword
