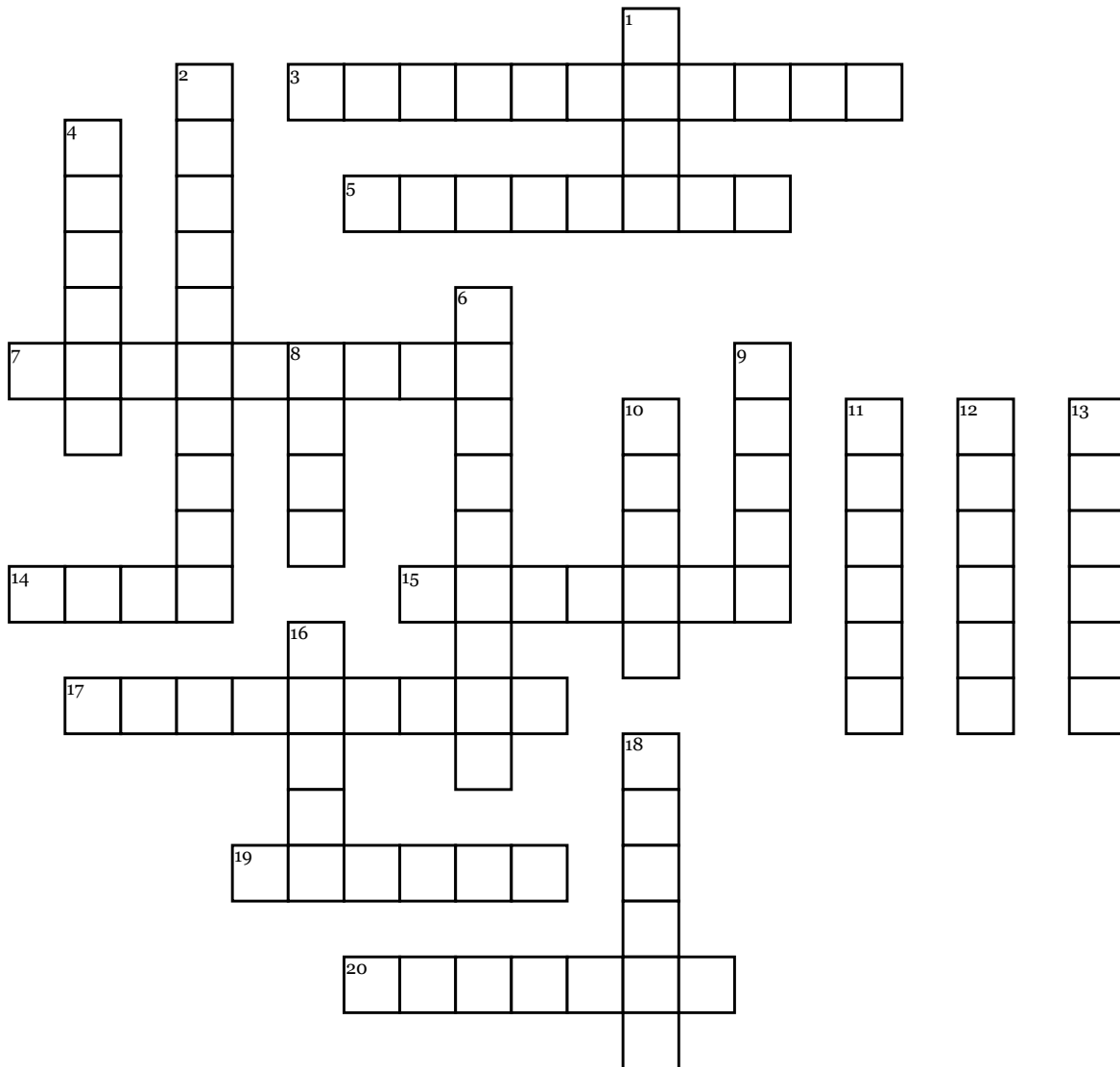


Social Studies Crossword
