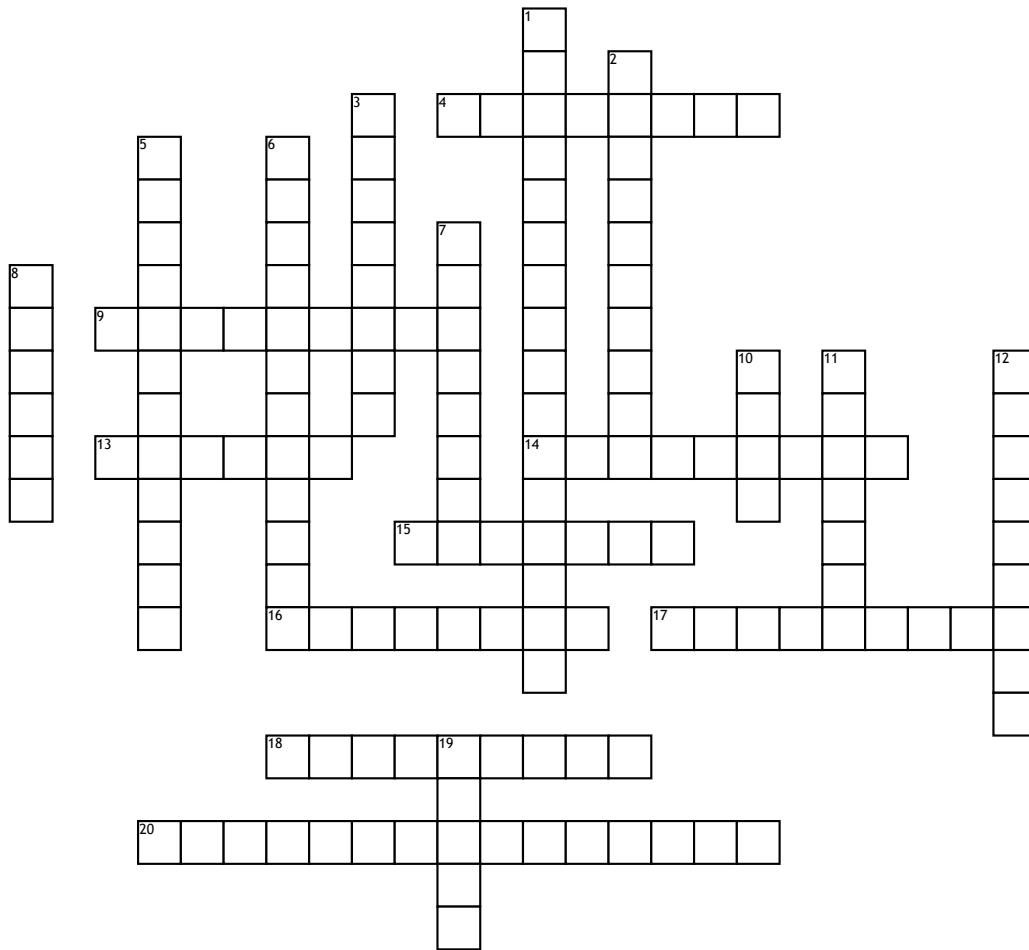


Social Studies Crossword Puzzle
