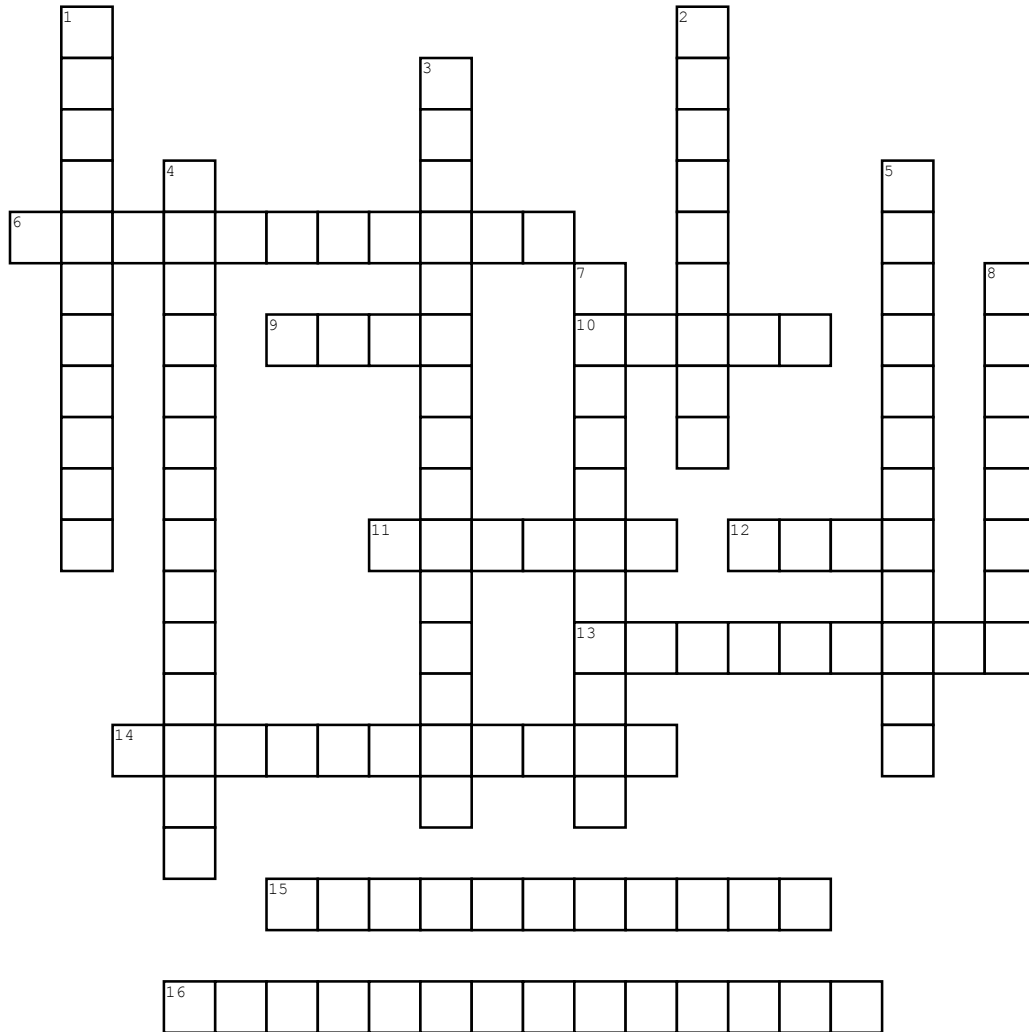


# Social World Crossword Puzzle
