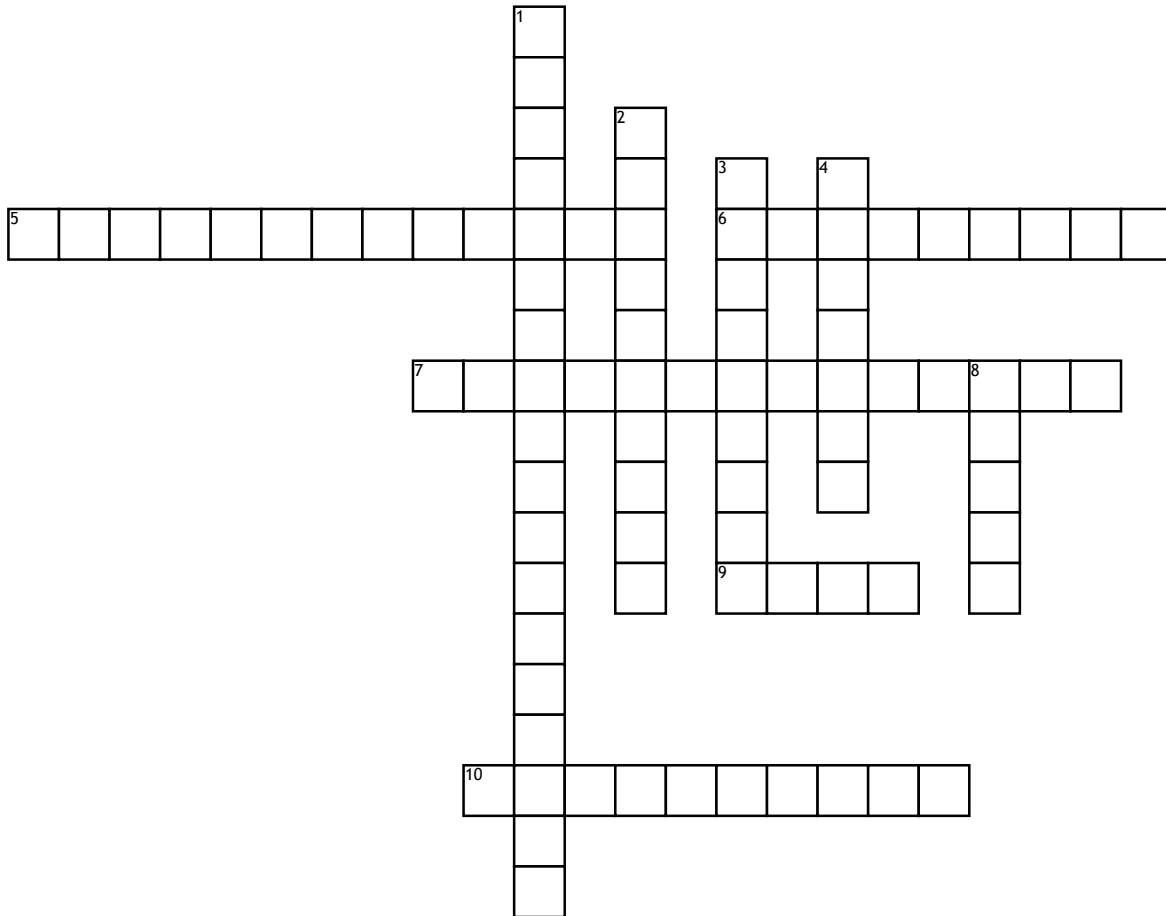

5. Part of the tripartite system, pupils who performed strongly in 11+.
6. State-funded schools, funded directly by the government rather than local education authority.
7. A student lives up the label given to them.
9. A project introduced in early 1980s to try address gender differences in subject choice and encourage more girls to choose sciences.
10. The 1944 Education Act introduced academic selection where pupils sat an exam to determine which school they should attend.

1. All students are taught the same topics at the same time in the same subjects.
2. One possible impact of a positive label being applied to pupils by teachers.
3. Theory developed by Howard Becker - in terms of pupil ability, potential or behaviour. Can be positive or negative.
4. Setting or streaming pupils of similar academic ability are taught together. Might be placed in the top, middle or lower.
