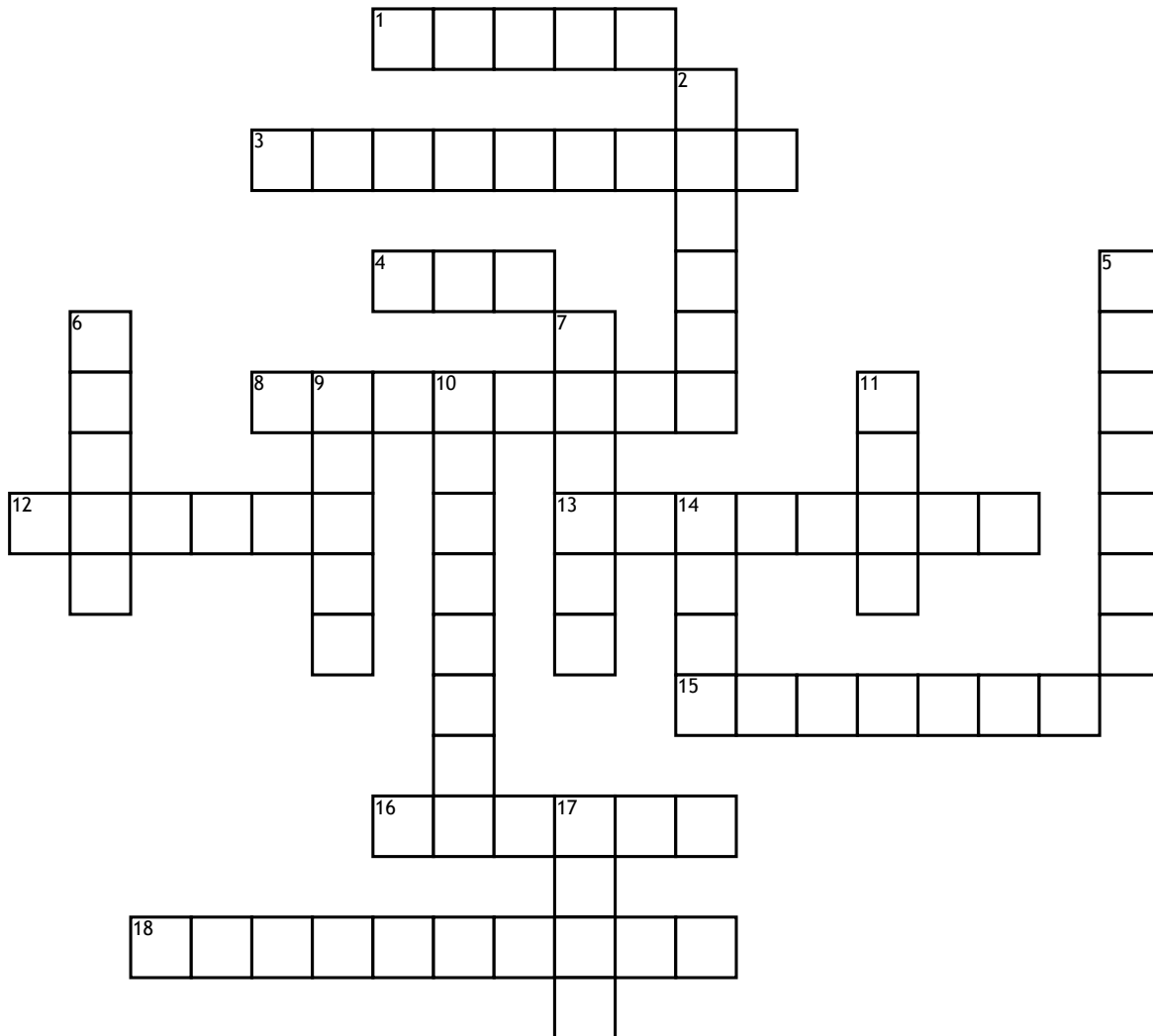


Solar Crossword Jess D
