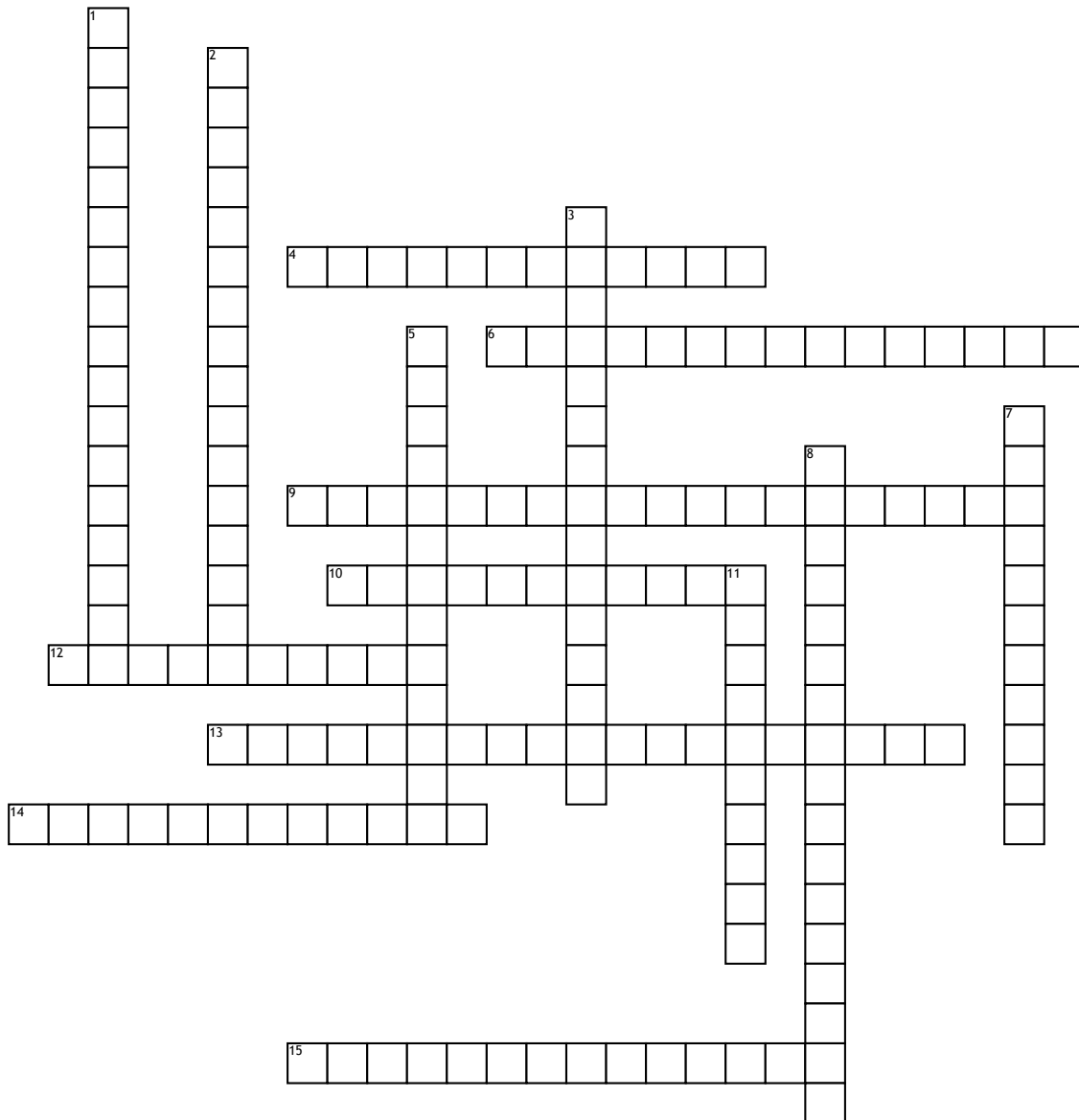


# Song Birds

4. Adults are brown on the upper parts with light spotting, resembling a piece of tree bark
6. They build a bulky nest on a horizontal tree limb in mid-story or the canopy of trees

1. This bird is a small North American song bird.
2. They primarily eat insects, but also consume arachnids, reptiles, amphibians, rodents, bats and small birds
3. inhabits the Eastern Rockies of Canada, and the Central-North and Northeastern United-States

5. The breeding habitat of the eastern phoebe is open woodland, farmland and suburbs
7. in Northern Europe it is the only common species called a "swallow" rather than a "martin".
8. Their underparts are white with rusty brown on the flanks; their back is grey
11. breeding range extends from Manitoba, Ontario and Nova Scotia in southern Canada to northern Florida and from the Atlantic coast to the Missouri River and the eastern Great Plains.
