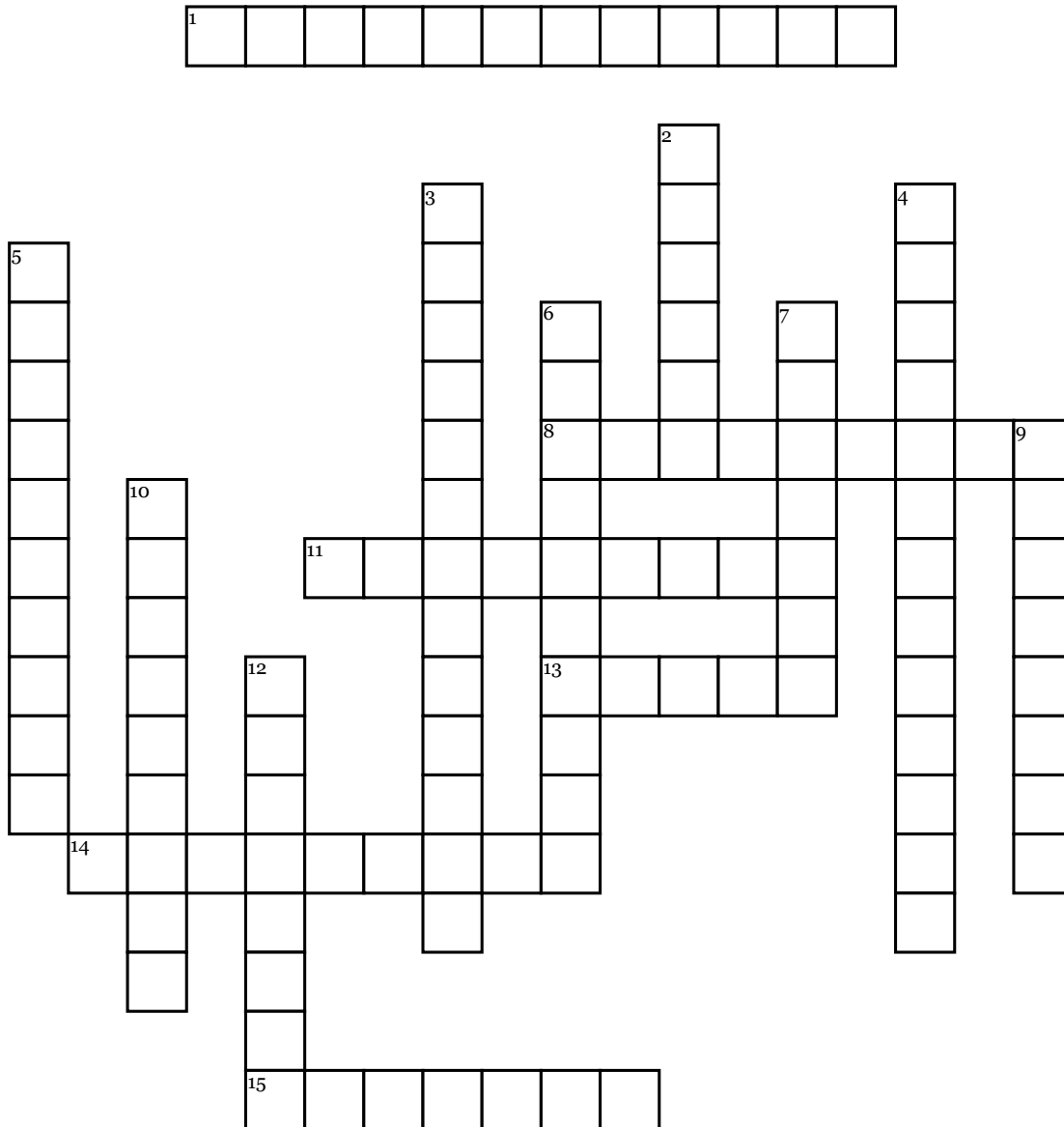


Space Travel and Technology
