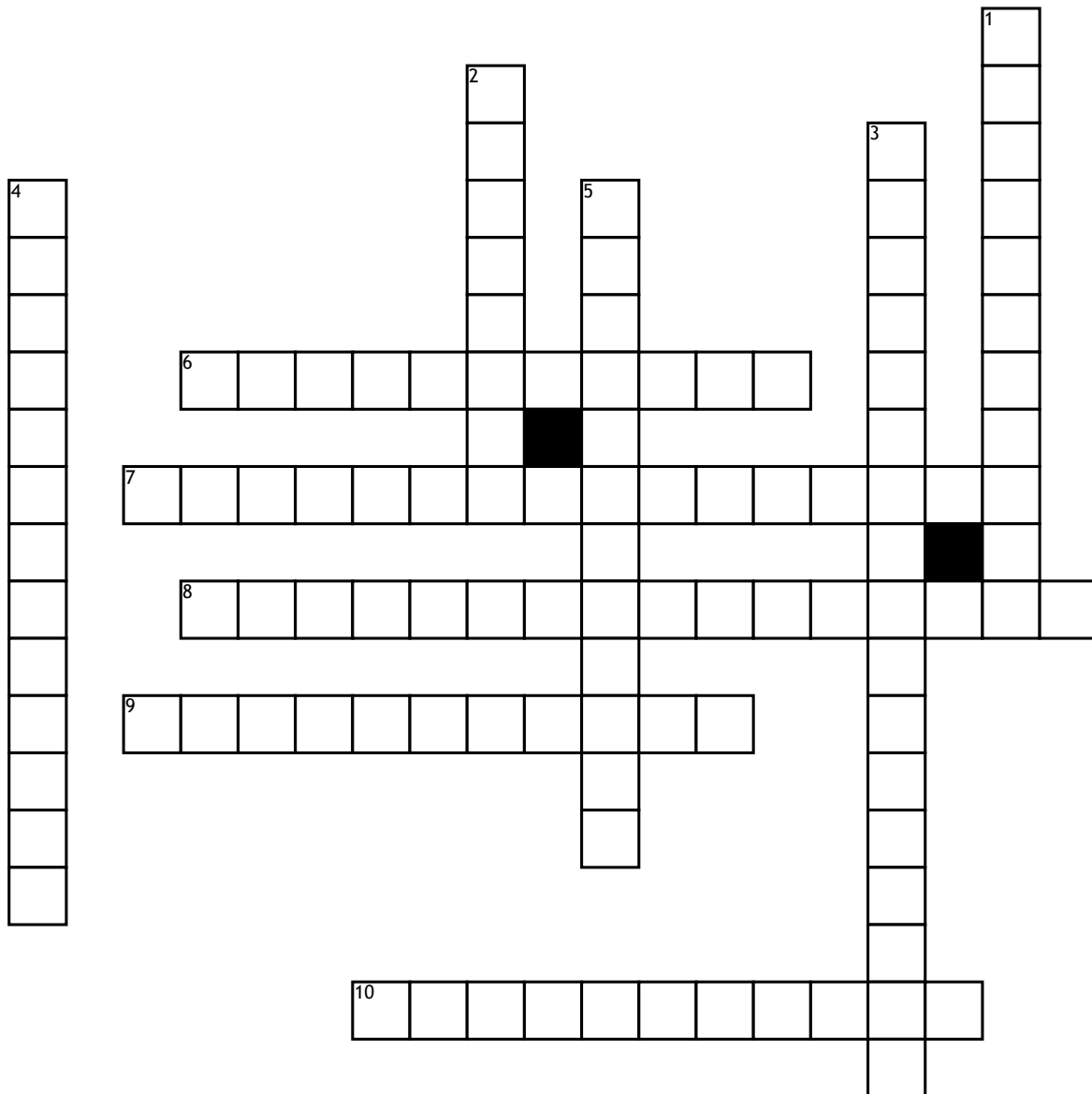


Spanish American War

- 1. A group of volunteer soldiers who fought on horseback (a Cavalry unit) during the Spanish American War

- 2. United States warship that exploded Havana Harbor, Cuba and is considered one of the causes of the Spanish American War
- 3. The nickname for the Spanish American War because it was short, inexpensive but the gains for the U.S. were huge; the United States gained new territories and was viewed as a World Power
- 4. The treaty that ended the Spanish American War; it gave Cuba its independence from Spain, the United States was given Puerto Rico and Guam and the U.S. was sold the Philippines for \$20 million
- 5. A policy of remaining apart from affairs of other countries, especially the political affairs of other countries
