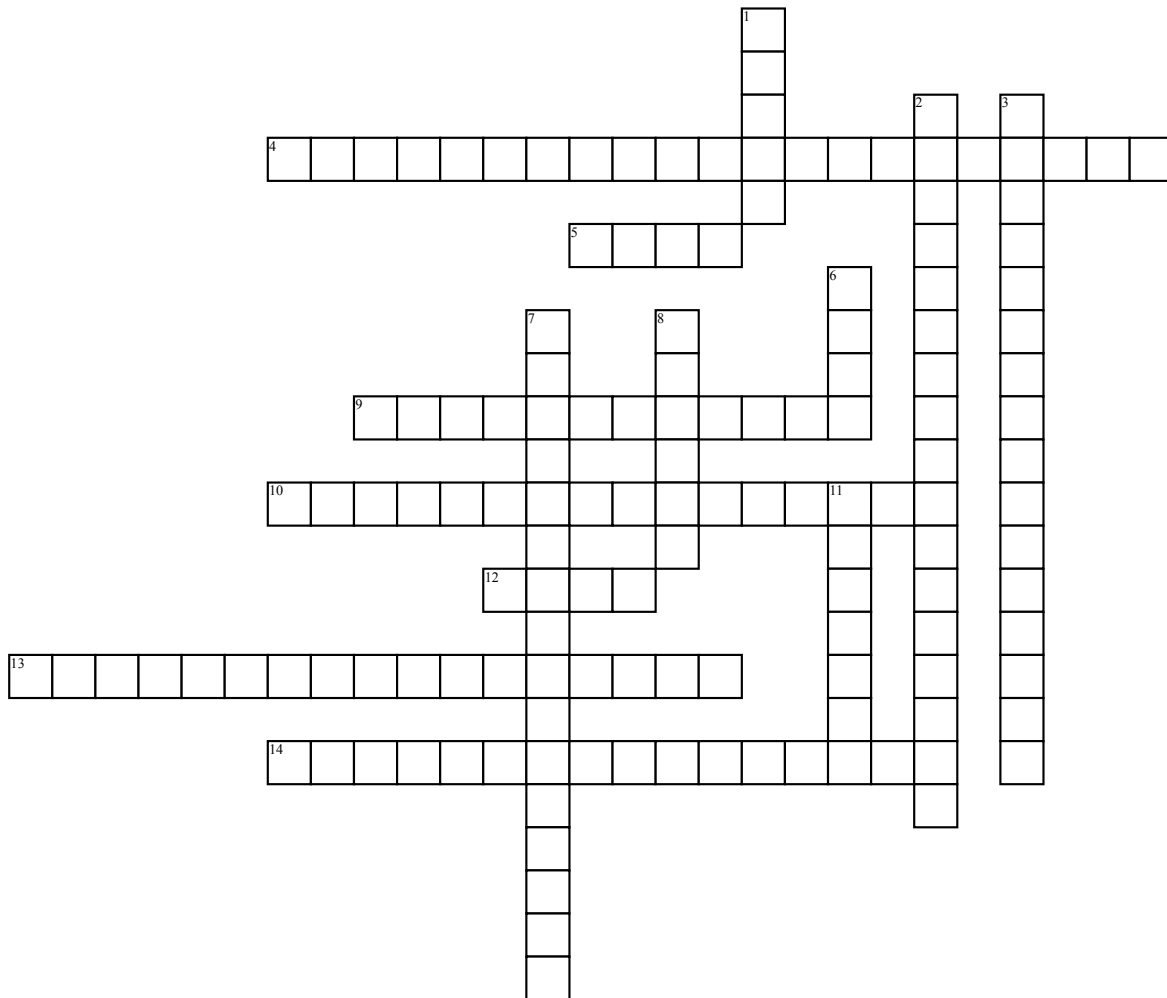


# Specialized Mucosa

1. The function of fungiform, foliate, and circumvallate papillae.  
 2. Type of mucosa found on the dorsal and lateral surfaces of the tongue.

3. Condition in which dead cells and keratin build up on the tongue.

6. The posterior 1/3 of the tongue.

7. A condition of the tongue that affects the sensitivity of filiform papillae.

8. Surface where fungiform and filiform papillae are located.

11. Surface where foliate papillae are located.
