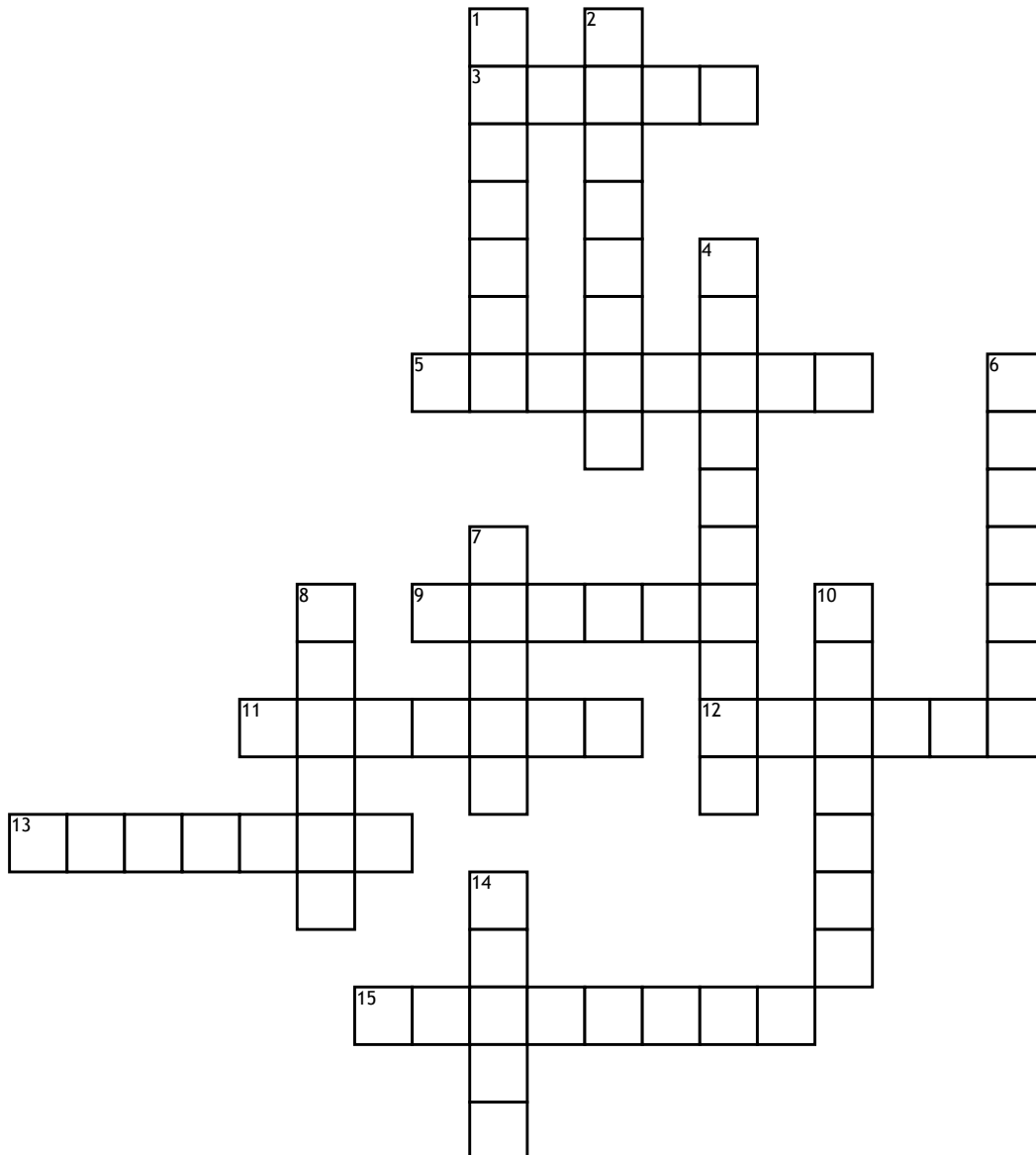


Spelling Word Crossword Puzzle
