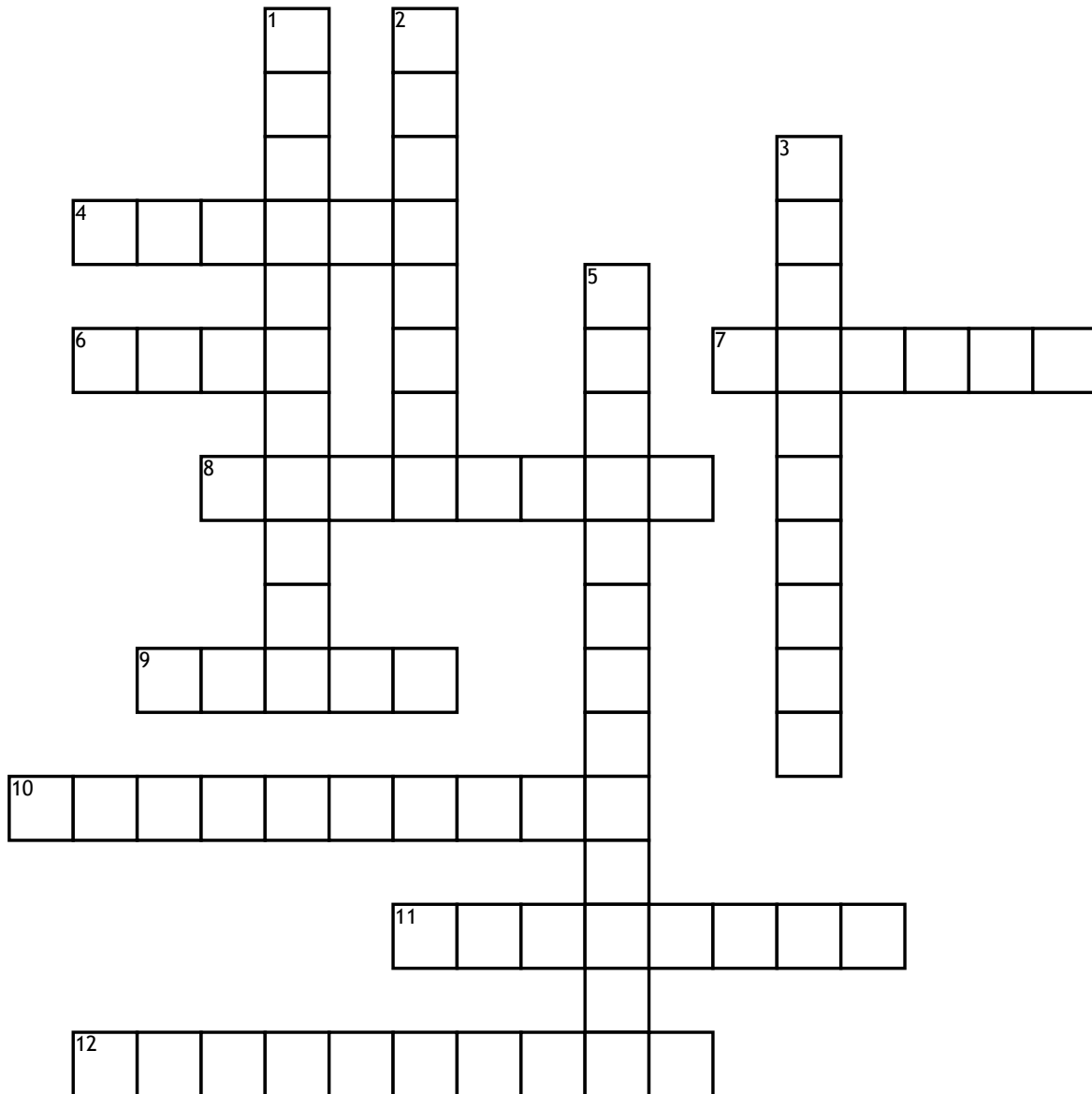


# Sponge Cake
