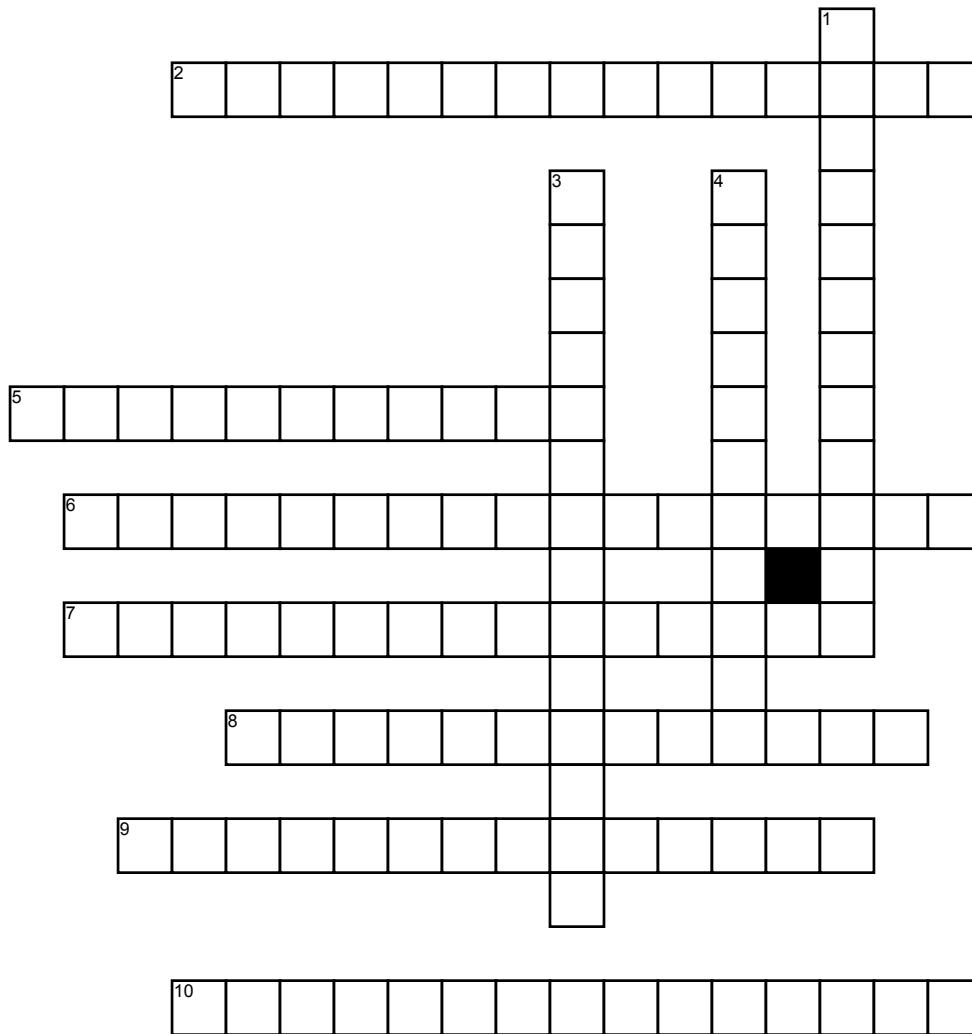

## Across

2. Typically are cylindrical with a bulb-shaped end and a classic, tan rind.
5. Shaped like its namesake, these popular winter squash are reliable performers.
6. The slender, curvy fruits of this Italian heirloom are firm and less seedy than many types.
7. A squash of a club-shaped variety with a curved neck and warty skin.
8. Has been popular in Europe for years.
9. Flying saucer-shaped squash can be grilled whole when 2 to 3 inches wide, or for larger fruits, dice and sauté or stuff.
