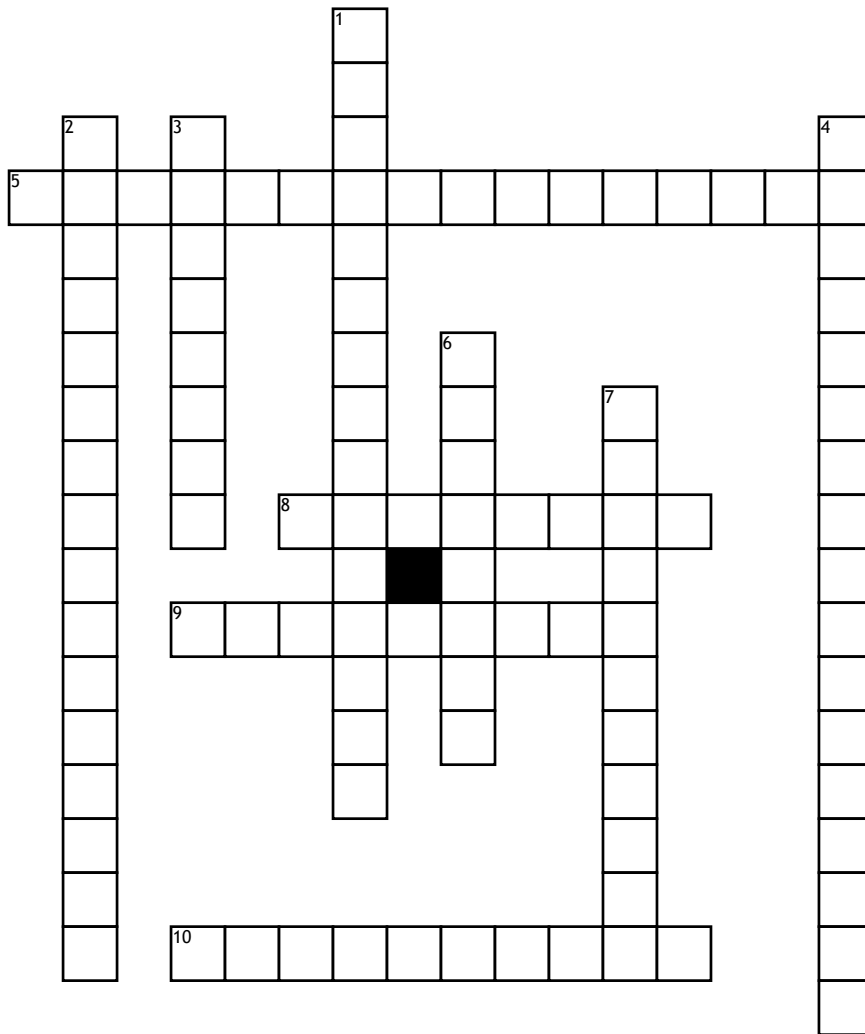


Standard 4 U.S History Crossword
