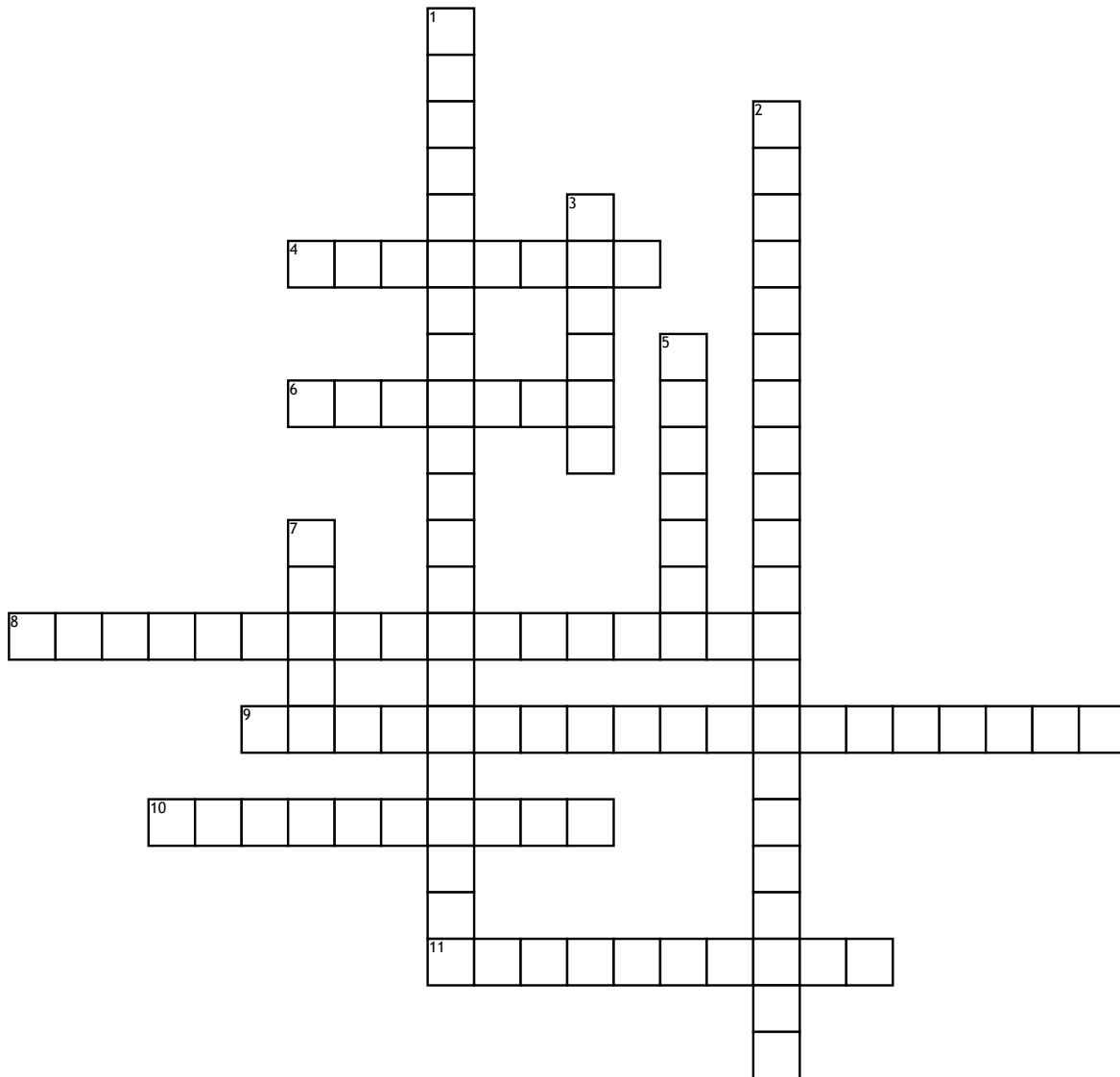


Statistics Crossword Puzzle
