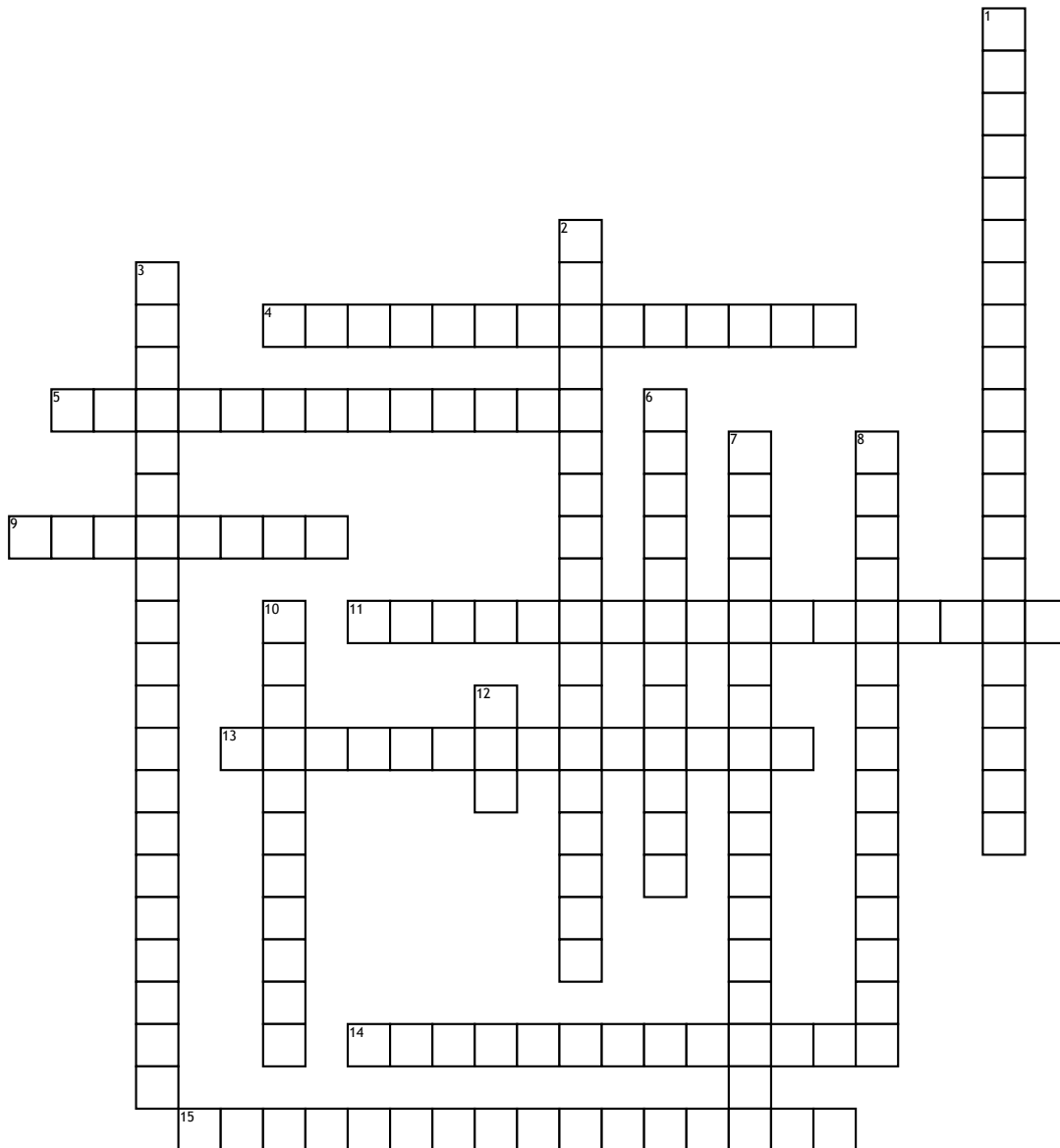

1. The ways in which individuals or groups are ranked in society, reflecting different amounts of power, status and prestige
