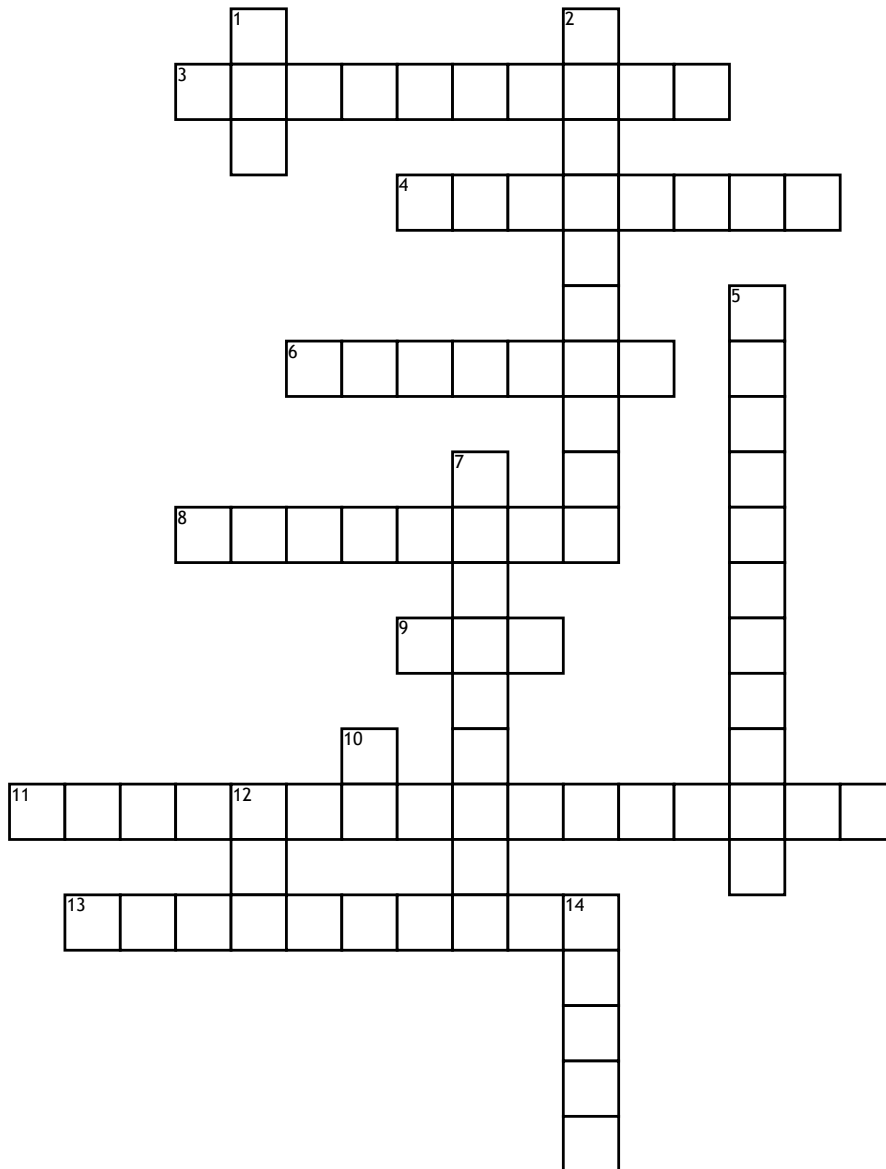


# Stroke Miscellaneous



## Across

3. Generic name for Pradaxa  
 4. center of memory and emotion - controls stress, rage, and anxiety  
 6. Impaired language output or interpretation  
 8. lobe responsible for coding visual memory and processing auditory, visual sensory input, and language comprehension  
 9. Cerebral blood vessel opens abnormally and spills blood into brain tissue (acronym)  
 11. Lovenox antidote (2 words and no space)

13. Speech disorder caused by muscle weakness

## Down

1. Aneurysm in the cerebral vasculature ruptures (acronym)  
 2. Cranial nerve that communicates pain, temp, and light touch of face, scalp, sinuses, and oral cavities)  
 5. Cranial nerve allows for control of tongue muscles, resulting in normal speech and swallow  
 7. Cranial nerve tests the movement of eyes downward and inward

10. Self-care and mobility measurement scale. Normal score is 100 and low score indicates higher disability and dependency (Acronym).

12. stroke symptoms involving this artery include contralateral motor and sensory deficits impacting the leg more than the arm, with the face and tongue spared.

14. Risk assessment tool used with TIA patients to assess their risk of stroke immediately following and up to 90 days after stroke
