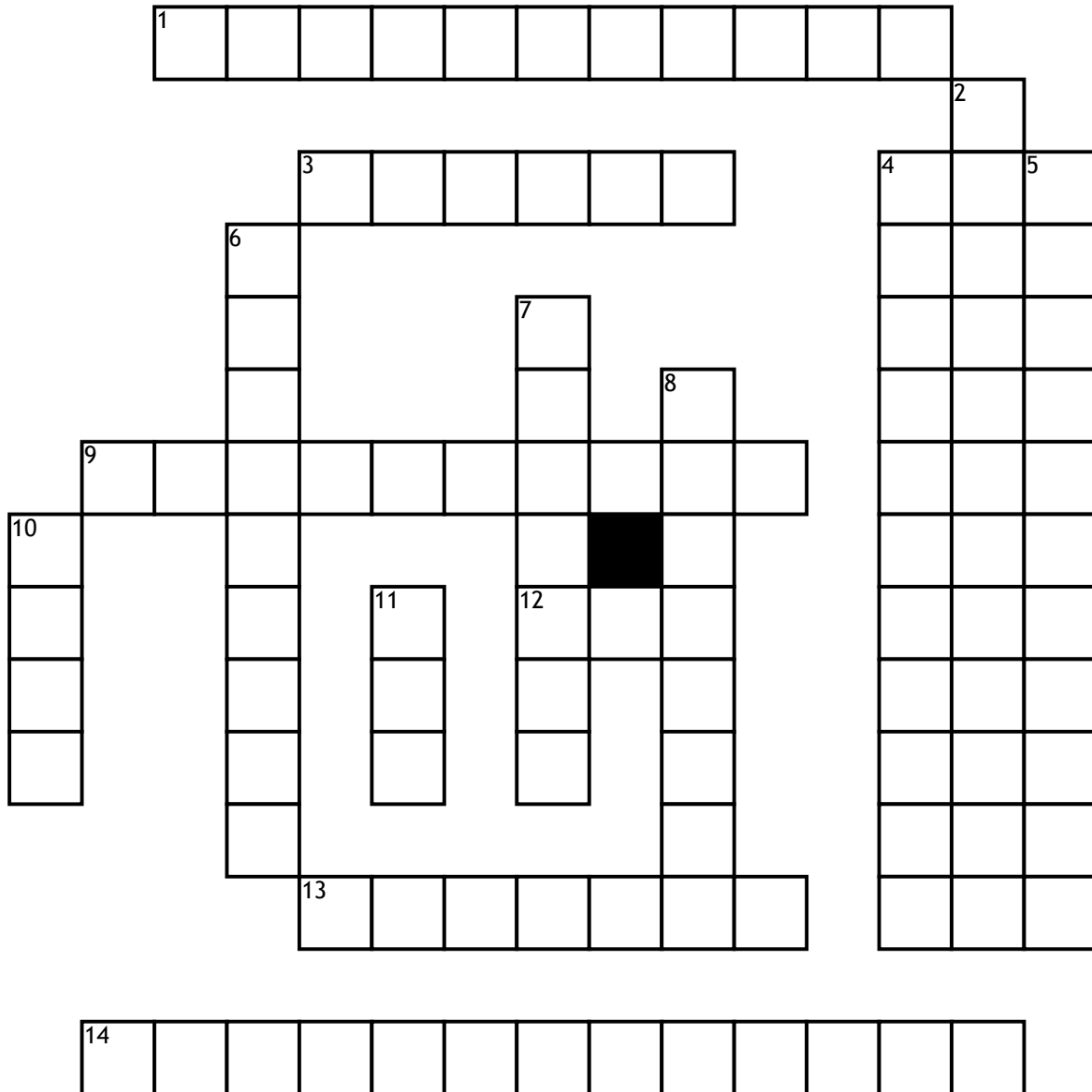


# Sunburn

- 2. Epidermis and Upperdermis is damaged, red with blister
- 4. Only the epidermis is damaged, red and swollen

- 5. Destroys entire skin layer.
- 6. Metastasized (moves) to other parts of the body
- 7. Red, sometimes swollen and painful skin
- 8. A tumor malanin forming cell, most serious type of skin cancer
