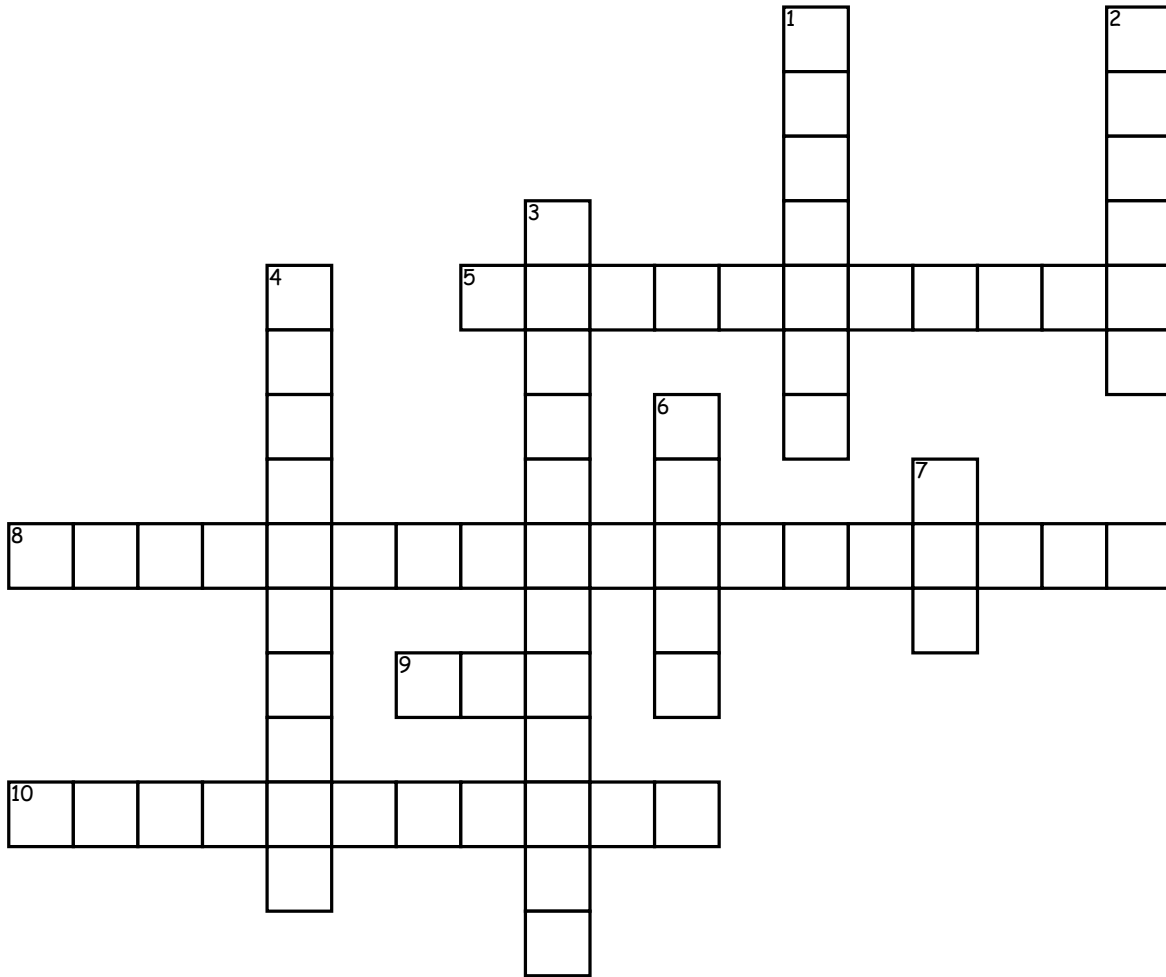


Supernumerary Teeth
